BACKGROUND:

Summary

On November 5, 2013, agenda item 3-10, the Board of Supervisors approved the Professional Services Agreement between the County and Huron Consulting Services, LLC in the amount of \$25,856,400. On November 26, 2013 the Board authorized Resolution 2013-276, a temporary transfer from the Waste Management Department Enterprise Fund to the RUHS Medical Center Enterprise Fund and set repayment terms of ten years plus interest as set-forth in Exhibit A of the resolution.

The Board desires to extend the repayment terms of the transfer and set a new repayment schedule to require payment of the temporary transfer by RUHS Medical Center Enterprise Fund, with interest, at a rate and times specified in Exhibit A to this Resolution 2017-153, which is a date before the funds are needed for their original intended purpose of long-term maintenance of landfills.

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RESOLUTION NO. 2017-153

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2013-276 BY EXTENDING THE REPAYMENT TERM ON A TEMPORARY TRANSFER OF WASTE MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT ENTERPRISE FUNDS TO THE RUHS MEDICAL CENTER ENTERPRISE FUND

WHEREAS, on November 5, 2013, in accordance with agenda item 3-10, the Board of Supervisors approved and authorized the Professional Services Agreement ("Agreement") between the County of Riverside ("County") and Huron Consulting Services, LLC ("Huron") for implementation of hospital financial performance and health system strategic plan programs in the amount of Twenty-Five Million Eight Hundred Fifty Six Thousand and Four Hundred Dollars (\$25,856,400); and

WHEREAS, California Government Code Section 25252 and 25261 authorize the Board of Supervisors to establish and abolish those funds necessary for the proper transaction of the business of the County and further provides that the Board of Supervisors may authorize the County Auditor to make such transfers from one fund to another when the Board of Supervisors has authority over each fund; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has authority over the Waste Disposal Enterprise Fund and the RUHS Medical Center Enterprise Fund and the public interest required a temporary transfer to be made from the Waste Disposal Enterprise Fund to the Riverside County Regional Medical Center Enterprise Fund in the amount of Twenty-Five Million Eight Hundred Fifty Six Thousand and Four Hundred Dollars (\$25,856,400) for the specific purpose of payment to Huron for services per the terms of the Agreement approved by the Board; and

WHEREAS, California case law (Auerbach v. Board of Supervisors of County of Los Angeles, 71 Cal. App. 4th 1427 (1999)) establishes the right of counties to temporarily transfer and loan money between funds until said moneys are needed to be spent for their original, intended purpose; and

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WHEREAS, the Board adopted Resolution 2013-276 on November 26, 2013 to authorize and direct the temporary transfer of Twenty-Five Million Eight Hundred Fifty Six Thousand and Four Hundred Dollars (\$25,856,400) to be transferred from the Waste Disposal Enterprise Fund to the RUHS Medical Center Enterprise Fund and set repayment terms of ten years plus interest as set-forth in Exhibit A to Resolution No. 2013-276.

WHEREAS, the Twenty-Five Million Eight Hundred Fifty Six Thousand and Four Hundred Dollars (\$25,856,400) transferred from the Waste Disposal Enterprise Fund to the RUHS Medical Center Enterprise Fund is not anticipated to be utilized for its original, intended purpose until after fiscal year 2026-2027.

WHEREAS the Board desires to extend the repayment terms of the transfer and set a new repayment schedule to require repayment of the temporary transfer by the RUHS Medical Center Enterprise Fund, with interest, at the rate and times specified in Exhibit A to this Resolution No. 2017-153, which is a date before said Twenty-Five Million Eight Hundred Fifty Six Thousand and Four Hundred Dollars (\$25,856,400) is needed for its original, intended purpose; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside assembled in regular session as follows:

- 1. The above recitals are true and correct.
- 2. The Exhibit A to Resolution No. 2013-276 is hereby deleted in its entirety and is replaced by the Exhibit A attached to this Resolution No. 2017-153. In addition, Section 4 of Resolution No. 2013-276 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the repayment provisions in Section 4 of this Resolution No. 2017-153.
- 3. The Auditor/Controller of the County is hereby authorized and directed to repay the temporary transfer to the Waste Disposal Enterprise Fund (sub-fund 40200) from the RUHS Medical Center Enterprise Fund (sub-fund 40054) as reflected in Exhibit A to this Resolution 2017-153. In addition, the Auditor/Controller of the County is hereby authorized and directed to make the necessary journal entries and to take such further acts as are necessary or convenient to affect the repayment as setforth here-in.

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- 4. The Auditor/Controller of the County shall ensure that the entire amount of the temporary transfer is repaid to the Waste Disposal Enterprise Fund (sub-fund 40200) by the RUHS Medical Center Enterprise Fund, with interest calculated and paid annually based on the County Treasurer Pool Rate, no later than June 30, 2027. To the extent that insufficient amounts have been received in the RUHS Medical Center Enterprise Fund to repay the entire amount of the temporary transfer plus interest on or before June 30, 2027, the repayment of any remaining, unpaid balance and interest shall come from such other unencumbered County General Fund monies as are lawfully available to make the repayment.
- 5. The Auditor/Controller of the County and any other County Officers are hereby authorized to take such additional actions as are necessary or convenient to carry out the effect of this resolution.
 - 6. This resolution shall take effect from and after its date of adoption.
