BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be allocated to the following organizations:

1. **True Innocents Equine Rescue - \$1,600** funds will be used to assist in improvements to the facility of the Rescue. The Rescue provides a home and treatment for neglected, abused, or abandoned horses in Western Riverside County.
2. **Rivers & Lands Conservancy - \$1,000** funding will be used to support the "Restore Our Arroyo" program. The program engages local community members to restore and care for the Prenda Arroyo, which is located in the First District.
3. **Fit One Foundation- \$1,500** funding will be used to provide training to volunteer (non-paid) instructors and to purchase equipment. FOF will be providing free fitness courses in under-served areas of the First District.
4. **Fair Housing Council of Riverside County (on behalf of Civil Rights Institute of Inland So. Cal) - \$1,000** funding will be used to support the development of the Civil Rights Institute of Inland Southern California, a project of the Fair Housing Council of Riverside County.
