BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be allocated to the following organizations:

- 1. True Innocents Equine Rescue \$1,600 funds will be used to assist in improvements to the facility of the Rescue. The Rescue provides a home and treatment for neglected, abused, or abandoned horses in Western Riverside County.
- 2. Rivers & Lands Conservancy \$1,000 funding will be used to support the "Restore Our Arroyo" program. The program engages local community members to restore and care for the Prenda Arroyo, which is located in the First District.
