BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be allocated to the following organizations:

1. **RCCD Foundation - \$2,000** funding will be used to support the RCC Starting Blocks Swim Program, which is housed at the Aquatics Complex and managed by the RCC Swim coaches and staff. The program focuses on increasing water safety skills by providing free swim and water safety lessons to children.
2. **A Salute to Veterans Parade Committee - \$2,500** funding will be used to support the Salute to Veterans Parade that will be held on November 18, 2017 in Riverside. The event is free and open to the public.
3. **CA Veterans of Foreign Wars Motorcycle Club, Empire Chapter - \$1,000** funding will be used to support the Emergency Food Assistance Program that serves veterans, active military families, widows, and shut-in seniors within the First District.
4. **Women Wonder Writers - \$1,000** funding will be used to assist with a Writing Workshop that will address resiliency, trauma, cultural sensitivity, and keys to success in overcoming juvenile delinquency and truancy and will be in collaboration with the Eastside Reconciliation Coalition Summer Youth Career Development Program.
