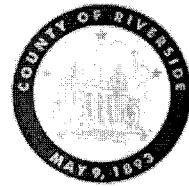





**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. The donation to Simple Acts of Care & Kindness will be used to host over 4000 4<sup>th</sup> grader students for the World Kindness Youth Conference, which encourages kindness among young people and increased violence and bullying prevention activities in schools.
2. The donation to the Mission Inn Foundation will be used to sponsor the annual Mission Inn Run which raises money to benefit both the foundation and museum, which supports art, history and cultural programs for residents, families, students and visitors.
3. The donation to Patriot High School Girls Soccer will be used to provide "Spirit Packs" which include 2 practice jerseys, socks, shorts and backpack. It will also help pay for some fees when the team enter competitions.
4. The donation to the Fender Museum of the Arts will be used to help provide music education to kids.
