



BACKGROUND:

1. The donation to Soroptimist International of Corona will be used to support the Live Your Dream Education and Training Award, which provides assistance to women who have overcome obstacles including poverty, domestic violence and/or drug abuse, in order for them to improve their education, skills and employment prospects.
