

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Find that the Polk Street Resurfacing and Sidewalk Improvement Project is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (c) - Existing Facilities; and
2. Approve the plans and specifications for the construction of the Polk Street Resurfacing and Sidewalk Improvement Project in the Community of Thermal; and
3. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, CA 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, September 20, 2017 at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days.



BACKGROUND:

Summary

Two Transportation Improvement Projects have been combined to bid as one project to reduce overhead costs and receive more favorable unit costs associated with larger quantities of work. The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) provides for the construction of the Polk Street Resurfacing Project between 58th Avenue and Airport Boulevard; and the Polk Street Sidewalk Improvement Project between Church Street and Airport Boulevard, both in the Community of Thermal in the east Coachella Valley area of Riverside County.

On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB1) was passed to improve the state's aging transportation infrastructure, particularly the roads and bridges. Because of this, the County is now able to improve the condition of roads in need of resurfacing or reconstruction and has included them in the County TIP. Without SB1 these needed road repair projects would have been shelved until funding became available.

The scope of work for the Polk Street projects includes resurfacing of approximately one mile of existing asphalt concrete pavement on Polk Street from 58th Street to Airport Boulevard; as well as, widening of an approximately 550-foot segment on the east side from Center Street to Airport Boulevard for construction of concrete curb, gutter, and sidewalk improvements from Church Street to Airport Boulevard.

Additional work includes adjustment of utilities to grade, placement of pavement markers, roadside signs, installing painted traffic stripes and thermoplastic pavement markings, and any other related work as may be required.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to legal form by County Counsel.

Environmental Findings

Because the Polk Street Resurfacing and Sidewalk Improvement projects consists of operation, maintenance and repair of an existing public facility, and there is no expansion of an existing roadway, this project qualifies for a Class 1 Categorical Exemption under Section 15301 (c) of the CEQA

Guidelines. In accordance with Section 15301 (c), Class 1 projects consist of the operation, repair and maintenance of existing public facilities, such as highways, streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails and similar facilities. Furthermore, the Coachella Valley MSHCP states that necessary operation and maintenance activities conducted for safety purposes along existing roadways are considered Covered Activities. The County of Riverside Transportation Department (Transportation Department) is requesting that the Board of Supervisors approve this environmental determination.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

These projects will increase mobility for pedestrians and increase public safety. The construction of an improved pedestrian route on Polk Street between Church Street and Airport Boulevard will benefit many residents in the area who walk to businesses and services, including schools, bus stops, markets and the nearby post office. The road resurfacing will provide the community with a safe dependable road for travel.

The work is scheduled to begin in the Fall of 2017. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction and will take approximately one month to complete.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$1,043,805. Construction is expected to begin and finish in FY 2017/2018 and will be funded with Gas Tax, and SB 821 funds for Bicycle and Pedestrian facilities, of which the Transportation Department successfully competed for.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

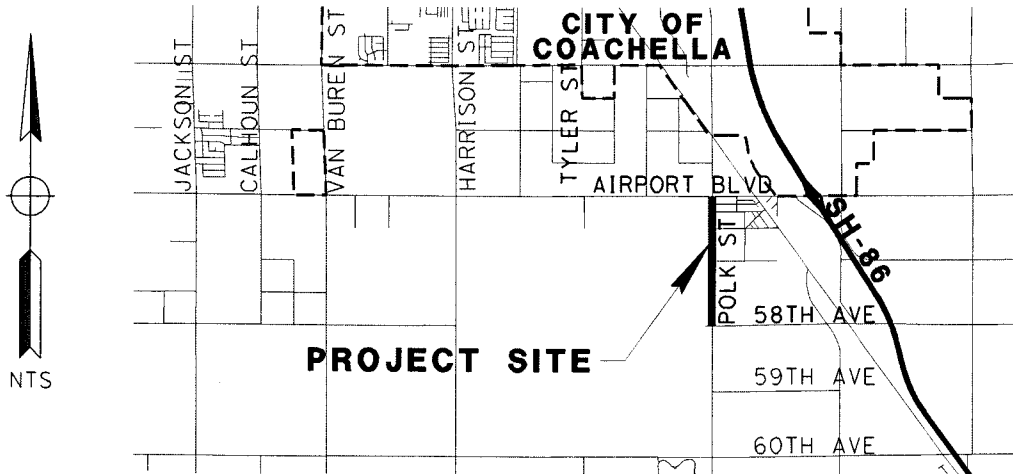
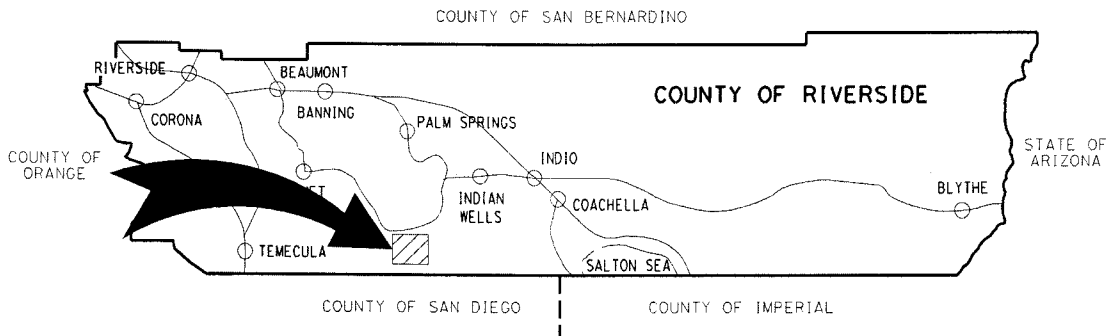

SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT: 4th District

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Riverside County Transportation Department (RCTD) is proposing to rehabilitate 1.00 mile of Polk Street from Airport Boulevard to 58 Avenue. Polk Street is a two lane arterial road with an average daily traffic of 2,100 cars per day. Polk Street varies in width from 24' to 53'. The proposed improvements consist of pulverizing the existing Asphalt Concrete (AC) and compacting to 95%, and overlaying the grinding with 0.25' Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA). The improvements also include re-striping the existing road, placing safety edge, and shoulder backing, and replacing signs. Polk Street will remain the same width and will not be widened. Polk Street will be raised by 0.25 inches and will need shoulder backing placed on both sides of the edge of pavement. No additional right-of-way will be required.

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS: Because the Project consists of operation, maintenance and repair of an existing public facility; and there is no expansion of the existing roadway, this Project qualifies for a Class 1 Categorical Exemption under Section 15301 (c) of the CEQA Guidelines. In addition, under Section 7.1 of the Coachella Valley Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan, all public facility construction, operation and maintenance activities outside conservation areas are Covered Activities. ¹ Note: If tree trimming and removal take place during the migratory bird breeding season (March 1 through September 1) a pre-construction nesting survey is required pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (MBTA).

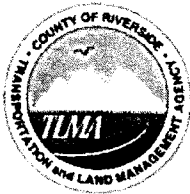

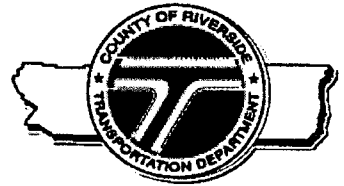

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The County of Riverside Transportation Department (RCTD) proposes to construct approximately 1000 liner feet of sidewalk, curb and gutter and install four ADA curb ramps on Polk Street in the Community of Thermal in Unincorporated Riverside County. Polk Street is a two lane road, with varying lane widths culminating in a maximum vehicular lane width of 20 feet. The right-of-way between 58th Ave and 57th Ave is 94 feet wide---composed of 64 feet to the left and 30 feet to the right of roadway centerline. The right-of-way between 57th Ave and Church Street is 119 feet wide---constituting 64 feet to the left and 55 feet to the right of roadway centerline. The proposed improvement will construct curb and gutter, driveway ties-in, sidewalk, and ADA curb ramps per County of Riverside Standard No. 200, 207, 401, 403 Case A, and 403 Case B. The improvements will also include shoulder backing to match back of sidewalk with the existing shoulder. The project will also include removal, salvaging and replacement of signs.

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

Because the Project consists of operation, maintenance and repair of an existing public facility; and there is no expansion of an existing roadway, this Project qualifies for a Class 1 Categorical Exemption under Section 15301 (c) of the CEQA Guidelines.
