

BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. **City of Palm Springs - \$1,000**
The City of Palm Springs will be hosting 21st Palm Springs Veteran Day Parade. This parade honors all who served, giving the community an opportunity to pay tribute to all our veterans. CID funds will be used towards the cost of the parade expenses such as barricades, pyrotechnics, lighting, sound, staging, advertising, and CHP staffing.

2. **Coachella Valley Rescue Mission - \$20,000**
Coachella Valley Rescue Mission provides food, shelter, clothing, counseling, and case management services for individuals who are homeless and displaced. CVRM Emergency Services program operates 24 hours a day which includes overnight shelters. CID funds will be utilized for operation of the Emergency Services program, shelter utilities including electricity, trash, telephone and water.

3. **Friends of the Desert Mountains - \$1,000**
Friends of the Desert Mountains mission is to preserve land, to support education, conservation and research in the Coachella Valley. Friends will be celebrating 30 years on November 3, 2017 at the Santa Rosa and San Jacinto Mountains National Monument Visitor Center. CID funds will be utilized towards the cost of the event.

4. **Inland Empire Coverage and Health Initiative - \$ 2,500**

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Inland Empire Coverage and Health Initiative promote information, education and enrollment to ensure children and families have access to affordable, quality health care. CID funds will be utilized towards the following activities; Medi-cal enrollment, IE-CHI Rural Task Force and IE-CHI Advocacy Task Force.

5. Regional Access Project Foundation - \$2,500

The RAP Foundation will hold its Non-profit Conference and Desert Fast Pitch on September 28, 2017. This event will provide expert speakers sharing resources and networking opportunities for non-profits professionals. Desert Fast Pitch, is a competition among nonprofits that teaches them how to effectively communicate their organization's message to potential supporters. Improving nonprofits' abilities to secure more funding for their vital services and projects will have a greater impact for eastern Riverside County residents. CID funds will be used to offset facility/technology costs.

6. Red Hot Ballroom Inc. - \$3,600

Red Hot Ballroom, Inc. is a non-profit after-school program providing students the opportunity to participate in dance instruction. This program is provided on site at 34 public schools in all three school districts: Coachella Valley Unified School District, Desert Sands Unified School District, and Palm Springs Unified School District. The dance program teaches social skills, self-esteem, respect for others and healthy physical exercise. At the end of the school year Red Hot Ballroom holds a dance competition among school districts. CID funds will be utilized toward the fee of the professional Youth Band, Heatwave Jazz and Show Band which will perform at all three Dance Competition Finals.
