



BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Care-A-Van Transit Systems, INC. \$5,000.00 - the funding will help transport seniors, disabled people, and the truly needy to medical appointments, social service agencies, education classes, job training, employment, social activities, and specialized services.
2. Temecula Valley Conservatory of the Arts \$2,000.00 - the funding will be used toward the purchase of instruments to start a beginning strings program at an elementary school in the Temecula Valley School District.
3. Hospice of the Valleys \$2,500.00 - the funding will support the "Wine and Chocolate" fundraiser, which will cover the costs of medication delivery, medical equipment, longer patient visits with medical professionals, and patients with limited or no insurance.
4. California Family Life Center \$2,500.00 - the funding will support the logistics and operating costs behind the benefit dinner and silent auction, "Our Family, Our Future," which raises funding to assist with gaps in funding, including counseling, food, shelter, and clothing.
