
SUBJECT: BOS DISTRICT 5: Fifth District Use of Community Improvement Designation (CID)

I request that the Board of Supervisors approve a contribution of \$250 to support this program.



BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation Funds will be allocated to one (1) 2017 High School Graduate, who served on the Fifth District Youth Advisory Council, and is a recipient of a Fifth District Youth Advisory Council Scholarship.

1. This scholarship award is designed to reward Fifth District Youth Advisory Council Members (YAC) hard work, assist in their education and improve our community.
 - a. All 12th grade YAC members were able to apply for this scholarship.
2. Eligibility considerations are as follows:

 - c. How many years served as a member on the YAC? (up to \$250 per year served)
 - d. Has the YAC member demonstrated any growth?

 - f. Provision of Official Transcript
 - g. Two letters of reference (only school personnel will be considered, i.e. academic counselor, teacher or club coordinator)
