#### **BACKGROUND:**

### **Summary**

The Southwest Communities Financing Authorities (SCFA) is an animal shelter constructed in southwestern Riverside County that joined together the interests of the Cities of Canyon Lake, Lake Elsinore, Murrieta, Temecula, Wildomar and the County of Riverside as the Joint Powers Authority (JPA) to oversee the management of the shelter of animals in the region. The Animal Shelter Operations Agreement, entered into August 10, 2010 between Animal Friends of the Valleys (AFV) and the SCFA JPA allows for the AFV to maintain and operate the shelter and provide animal shelter activities and services to ensure the health and safety of the animals in the region.

Section 8, Scope of Shelter Services, Subsection p. Vaccination Clinics, the First Amendment to the Second Amended and Restated Animal Shelter Operations Agreement is amended to reflect specific days and hours of operation of the clinics in order to best serve the patrons in the region. Subsection p. is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the language as noted in the attachment.

The Animal Shelter Operations Agreement requires that any amendments be approved by AFV, SCFA JPA Board of Directors, and the County of Riverside. The First Amendment to the Second Amended and Restated Animal Shelter Operations Agreement has been approved by the SCFA JPA Board of Directors and AFV. The final requirement for the amendment to be adopted is approval by the County.

#### Impact on Residents and Businesses

Pursuant to the Operations Agreement, AFV provides a broad range of animal shelter activities for the purpose of safeguarding the health and safety of the population of the SCFA entities and the health and safety of its domestic animals, and for the purpose of promoting the humane treatment of animals.

#### First Amendment to the Second Amended and Restated

## **Animal Shelter Operations Agreement**

This 1st Amendment to the Second Amended and Restated Animal Shelter Operations Agreement ("Contract") is made and entered into as of <u>Feb 2</u>, 2017, by and between Southwest Communities Financing Authority ("SCFA") and, Animal Friends of the Valleys ("AFV")

#### **RECITALS**

SCFA, a California joint powers authority, and AFV, a California non-profit corporation, entered into the Second Amended and Restated Animal Shelter Operations Agreement on July 1, 2015, and it is in effect through June 30, 2020. The Agreement is amended as follows:

- 1. Section 8 Scope of Shelter Services subsection p Vaccination Clinics, is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following language:
- (p) Vaccination Clinic. AFV shall provide a vaccination clinic on weekdays between the hours of 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at the clinic located at 29001 Bastron, Lake Elsinore, CA 92530. SCFA shall allow AFV to conduct the sale of licenses on behalf of all SCFA member agencies at the clinic. AFV shall transmit all license monies collected, or alternately provide a credit for such monies, to the appropriate SCFA member agency within thirty (30) days. In addition AFV shall maintain an adequate record of identifying information in connection with all license holders' from whom license monies are collected.
- Except as set for in this Amendment, the Contract is unaffected and shall continue in full
  force and effect in accordance with its terms. If there is conflict between this amendment
  and the Agreement or any earlier amendment, the terms of the First Amendment will
  prevail.
- 3. If any of this 1<sup>st</sup> Amendment or the Contract is declared invalid, illegal or otherwise unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect.
