BACKGROUND:

Summary

On July 25, 2017, the presence of the bacterial agent that causes citrus greening disease, or huanglongbing (HLB) was confirmed from a tissue culture collected from a backyard grapefruit tree in the city of Riverside. HLB is a fatal disease of citrus trees and is spread through feeding action of the Asian citrus psyllid (ACP).

HLB originated in Asia, and is considered the most devastating disease of citrus in the world. Symptoms of HLB include yellow shoots with mottling and chlorosis of the leaves, misshapen fruit that does not fully color and fruit that has a very bitter taste making it unfit for human consumption. The bacterium that causes the disease blocks the flow of nutrients within the tree, causing the tree to starve. There is no cure and trees infected with the disease will die.

This disease has nearly destroyed the citrus industry in Florida and Texas. In Florida, it is estimated that the presence of HLB has resulted in a loss of over \$7 billion and 6,600 jobs over the last five years. Prior to the Riverside find, HLB was discovered in Los Angeles and Orange Counties.

The presence of ACP and now HLB in Riverside County presents a serious threat to our annual \$187 million commercial citrus production as well as the tradition of backyard and landscape citrus plantings throughout the County. The history of Riverside County is rooted in citrus. The risks posed by the continued spread of ACP and HLB constitute a local emergency within Riverside County.

It is requested that the Board of Supervisors adopt Resolution No. 2017-196 proclaiming a Local Emergency.

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RESOLUTION NO. 2017-196

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE DECLARING THE EXISTANCE OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 8630 authorizes the Board of Supervisors to proclaim the existence of a "local emergency"; and,

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 8558(c) defines such conditions as "air pollution, fire, flood, storm, epidemic, riot, drought, sudden and severe energy shortage, plant or animal infestation or disease, the Governor's warning of an earthquake, or volcanic prediction or an earthquake or other conditions, other than resulting from a labor controversy, which conditions are likely to be beyond the control of the services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of that political subdivision and requiring the combined forces of other political subdivisions to combat"; and,

WHEREAS, citrus greening disease, or huanglongbing is a devastating disease that threatens citrus trees in Riverside County; and,

WHEREAS, the Asian Citrus Psyllid is a vector for the bacterium that causes huanglongbing; and,

WHEREAS, the Asian Citrus Psyllid and huanglongbing were confirmed in Riverside County by lab analysis and visual survey; and,

WHEREAS, the potential exists for the spread of huanglongbing throughout Riverside County, causing significant economic peril to the citrus industry consisting of approximately 16,500 acres and annual production valued at \$187 million; and,

WHEREAS, huanglongbing may have the ability to spread to other areas, especially the San Joaquin Valley, which contains large acreages of citrus; and,

WHEREAS, researchers at the University of California, Riverside are engaged in scientific studies aimed at early detection of huanglongbing and development of control practices for the Asian Citrus Psyllid and huanglongbing; and,

WHEREAS, the aforementioned conditions of extreme peril warrant and necessitate the proclamation of a "local emergency".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED AND PROCLAIMED that a "local emergency" exists throughout the County of Riverside; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that all County officials and employees cooperate and coordinate efforts with officials and employees of other political subdivisions

1	and officials and employees of the state and federal government in bringing the present condition of local emergency under control; and,
