



BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. JDS Creative Academy (\$1,000.00) - the funding will support the Scholarship Fund project, which finances free classes for foster youth and provides scholarships to less privileged members of the academy.
2. Anza Valley Christian Men's Service Club (\$2,000.00) - the funding will support the distribution of USDA food to anyone seeking assistance in the Anza area.
3. A Salute to Veterans Parade Committee (\$1,000.00) - the funding will support the operations and logistics of the parade, which recognizes the thousands of local veterans living in Riverside County.
4. Assistance League of Temecula Valley (\$3,000.00) - the funding will support Operation School Bell, a program that provides new, school-appropriate clothing for K-12 students attending school districts within Riverside County District 3.
