- 3. Direct the Executive Office to transfer up to \$9,100 from DIF Fund No. 30535 and \$5,190 from DIF Fund No. 30568 to EDA, as needed, pursuant to billings received from the Economic Development Agency.

## **BACKGROUND:**

## **Summary**

The Development Impact Fee (DIF) Program was established in Riverside County via Ordinance No. 659. When DIF was originally established, the fees were collected in "Area Plans" fund categories for specific functional components; including major improvements, community center/park facility, and flood control; rather than specific project lists. Fund 30535 was established for the community center/park component for the Greater Elsinore Area Plan (AP15), and Fund 30568 was established for the community center/park component for the Mead Valley Community Center/Park Facility Fund (AP13).

Improvements are needed at both the Lakeland Village Community Center and the Mead Valley Community Center. The County proposes utilizing DIF Fund 30535 and DIF Fund 30568, respectively, to fund these improvements.

# Impact on Residents and Businesses

Completing improvements at the Lakeland Village Community Center and the Mead Valley Community Center will improve the provision of programs to the residents utilizing these community centers.
