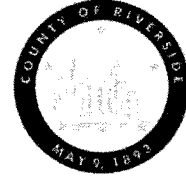



1. Approve the Registrar of Voters to conduct election services for the November 7, 2017 Consolidated General Election for various local jurisdictions.


