BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be allocated to the following organization:

- California Riverside Ballet \$1,500 funds will be used to assist with student tuition for The Academy Program, a dance training program for underserved youth, at the Ysmael Villegas and Arlanza Community Centers.
