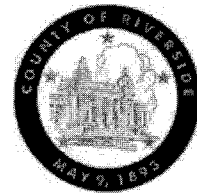



BACKGROUND: Community Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

2. The Hispanic Association of Small Businesses donation will be used for annual support for their operations and services that will help promote economic improvement to small minority owned businesses in the communities.
3. Inland Empire Hispanic Leadership Council annual support will be used towards programs and services such as mentoring, educational programs, health programs and leadership empowerment.
4. The Moreno Valley Cultural Arts Foundation support will be used towards classes, workshops, and programs such as the "Boundaries Bashfest" to provide programming focused on the disabled and under-served communities.
