



**BACKGROUND:** Community Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Carol's Kitchen annual support funding will be used for operations and services that provide hot nutritious lunches to the needy in the San Geronio Pass area to help reduce hunger, isolation and depression.
2. Fair Housing Council of Riverside County donation will be used for annual support for their operations, programs and services such as the Civil Rights Institute of Inland Southern California program, the Annual Housing Conference and the Champions of Change Awards.
3. Riverside National Cemetery Support Committee annual support will be used towards programs, services and events that serve and salute our veterans such as the Concert for Heroes and the Indigent Unclaimed Homeless Veterans Ceremony.
