BACKGROUND:

SUMMARY

Continued WQMP Review Services are needed to provide access to expertise and additional personnel, enabling the Transportation Department to efficiently manage peak work flows and supplement our core staff.

The Board of Supervisors approved and executed an agreement between the County and Atkins North America, Inc. to provide WQMP Review Services for a period of three years, on March 10, 2015 (Agenda Item 3-40). The agreement allows for two separate one-year extensions to extend the term of the contract. The attached amendment exercises the option to extend the term of the contract for the first of the two optional one-year extensions. The continued services of Atkins is needed to provide on-going WQMP Review Services for fiscal year 2017-2018. The continued specific services to be provided include, but are not limited to, plan check review of WQMP's and other WQMP and water quality protection assistance related to development activities.

Three additional consultants have been approved by the Board of Supervisors to provide WQMP review services. Contracting with four consultants for the same services allows the department to assign work to the firm or firms with expertise in specific types of development and knowledge of watershed-specific WQMP requirements; avoids potential conflicts between WQMP reviewers and preparers; and allows the department to balance the work load to ensure timely reviews.

This 1st Amendment to the Agreement will extend the term of the contract for the first of the two optional one-year extensions. Due to the institution of efficiency changes to the WQMP plan check process, the Transportation Department has been able to reduce the time spent on WQMP reviews; therefore, the budget for the 1st Amendment to the Agreement will be reduced to the amount of \$75,000 for Fiscal Year 17/18.

County Counsel has approved the Agreement, Amendment No. 1, as to legal form.

Impact on Residents and Businesses:

Atkins's services are needed to provide access to expertise and additional personnel needed to review WQMP's in an expedient manner and provide certainty for the processing of development project submittals.

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Additional Fiscal Information:

All associated contract costs will be funded using Deposit Based Fees. Thus, no net County costs will be incurred as a result of the contract extension.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness:

The Transportation Department has contracted Atkins under this agreement since 2015. The billing rates for professional services from Atkins remain unchanged from the billing rates included in the underlying 2014 agreement. The billing rates were developed by negotiations between Atkins and the Transportation Department staff using the County's Purchasing Department policies and guidelines.

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1st AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT

For On-Call Engineering Services

Between County of Riverside – Transportation Department

And Atkins North America, Inc

THIS AMENDMENT (hereinafter the "1st Amendment") to an Agreement is made and entered into as of this 24th day of 6th day of 2017, by and between the County of Riverside, a political subdivision of the State of California (hereinafter the "COUNTY"), Atkins North America, Inc. (hereinafter "ENGINEER").

RECITALS

- A. COUNTY and ENGINEER have entered in an agreement entitled "Engineering Services Agreement of On-Call Water Quality Management Plan Check Services between County of Riverside Transportation Department and Atkins North America, Inc. that is dated March 10, 2015 (M.O. 3.40) (hereinafter the "Agreement"). The Agreement provides the terms and conditions, scope of work, schedule and budget for the performance of professional and technical services necessary to provide on-call engineering services. The Agreement provides for a three year initial term with two 1-year time extensions.
- B. Appendix B Article BI establishes the time period for allowing work assignments to be authorized under the original agreement. The terms and conditions specify that work assignment can be authorized until June 30, 2017 and that the authority to approve and execute work assignments can be modified through one-year supplemental extensions. The agreement allows for two separate one-year extensions.
- C. The ENGINEER is satisfactorily performing the duties under this Agreement and the Transportation

 Department continues to need the services provided. The parties therefore now desire to implement the first one-year extension of the authority to approve and execute work assignments.

AGREEMENT

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants hereinafter contained, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. The authority to authorize work assignments under this contract is hereby extended from July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2018 in accordance with Appendix B Article BI of the original agreement.
- 2. The contract maximum as set forth in Article VI COMPENSATION, subsection B.1. and Appendix C Article CV COST PROPOSAL are hereby modified and shall reflect that the compensation for this 1-year time extension shall not exceed \$75,000.00 annually upon execution of this Agreement.
- 3. Except to the extent specifically modified or amended hereunder, all of the terms, covenants and

conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect between the parties hereto.
