**BACKGROUND:**

1. The donation to NAMI Walks Inland Empire will sponsor their annual walk on October 28, 2017, which will raise money for vital programs in Riverside County such as Family-to-Family, a 12-week class for family members of persons with mental health diagnosis.
2. The donation to Inland Empire Coverage and Health Initiative will be used to help promote education and enrollment in health insurance by partner health teams in various venues such as schools, community clinics and child development centers, with a focus on Latino children and families. In addition to providing enrollment, partners help families utilize their insurance for better health outcomes.

4. The donation to Calicinto Ranch will be used to fund a 3-5 day camp for children of prisoners, with a mission to give the children positive life-changing experiences to help break the cycle of crime for generations to come.
