BACKGROUND:

Summary

As a requirement of the Federal Qualified Health Center (FQHC) designation, the County must have a Community Health Center Board, which is authorized by County Ordinance. There are thirteen (13) to twenty-five (25) positions on the Board which a majority must be users of services at the Community Family Care Centers. Board members must also be broadly representative of the characteristics of the population served. The individuals in the motion has been reviewed and accepted by the Community Health Center Boards.
