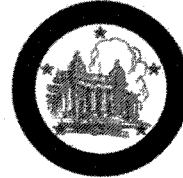



BACKGROUND:

Summary

On July 21, 2015, Agenda Item 3.43 and 3.62 were approved by the Board, with strict limitations to dollar amounts for various Agreement types with specific delegation of signature authority.

The July 1, 2015; Agenda Item 3.62 for the approval of Resolution 2016-157 which Authorize the Purchasing Agent to Initialize and Implement Public Contract Code Section 20131, subsection (c), for Procurement not to Exceed \$750,000 per Vendor Per Twelve Month Period was renewed and approved by the Board on July 12, 2016, Agenda Item 3-29 and again on July 11, 2017, Agenda Item 3.42.

Riverside University Health System-Medical Center (RUHS-MC) had two primary goals in seeking limited delegation authority. The primary objective was to reduce the time normally required to finalize an Agreement. Typical Agreements might provide equipment for patient service, initiate student internships, or they might generate new net revenue. In each case there is a sizable benefit to expediting the approval process. The secondary objective was to remove items that are repetitive or routine and thus help declutter the Board agenda

In the first full year sixty-one (61) beneficial Agreements have been signed, including Affiliation Agreements with Universities to provide training to students and doctors, Agreements with health insurance providers like Inland Empire Health Plan (IEHP) that facilitated the transfer of significant payments, Cooperative Agreements with other area hospitals that support patient transfers, Agreements that accept grant awards, Agreements with local pharmacies to provide prescription drug services for our patients, and Agreements with various medical groups to provide specialty Physician services. The pharmacy Agreements and the grants generate revenue for the hospital without increasing costs to patients.

Incorporated into this Board action is a report of all the Agreements signed in the fourth quarter from Fiscal Year 2016/2017.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Delegated authority allows for patient services to be delivered faster. Those Agreements that increase revenue or accelerate payments improve the hospital's fiscal health.
