



BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. All From The Heart \$2,500.00 - the funds will be used for the Wheels for Warriors project, in which power wheelchairs are refurbished and given to veterans in need.
2. Assistance League of Hemacinto \$3,000.00 - the funds will be used to support Operation School Bell, which provides new school clothes to children from low income families.
3. Green Acres Interactive Therapy (G.A.I.T) \$2,500 - the funds will be used for operation expenses for their program, which provides physical and emotional therapy through horse and farm animal interaction.
