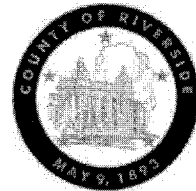



BACKGROUND:

1. The donation to the Family Service Association will be used to purchase gifts for foster children in the Second District as well as food and gifts for needy families at the Norton Younglove Community Center.
2. The donation to Catholic Charities will assist with their Homeless Prevention Program, which includes preventing homelessness by assisting families whose current housing is at-risk, provide emergency, temporary transitional shelter for newly homeless families and assist homeless families to obtain permanent housing.
3. The donation to the Vivian Stancil Olympian Foundation will be used to teach water safety, both in and near the water. Their target population is infants, seniors and persons with disabilities.
4. The donation to Friends of the Corona Library will sponsor their annual fundraiser, which raises funds for literacy programs at the library.
