The Southern California Water Committee (SCWC), established in 1984, is a nonprofit, nonpartisan public education partnership dedicated to informing southern Californians about our water needs and our State's water resources. Through measured advocacy, SCWC works to ensure the health and reliability of southern California's water supply. SCWC's members include leaders from businesses, regional and local government, agricultural groups, labor unions, environmental organizations, water agencies, flood control districts as well as the general public.

The SCWC coordinates regional education programs and coordinates task forces that facilitate District federal stormwater permit compliance, promote District water conservation goals and facilitate laws, regulations and permits that promote stormwater capture for water supply purposes.

The District's membership fee will cover membership for both the District and Riverside County.
