

**SUBMITTAL TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE,
STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation Funds will be allocated to two (2) 2017 High School Graduates who have served on the Second District Youth Advisory Council.

1. The scholarship award is designed to reward Second District Youth Advisory Council Members (YAC) hard work and to assist with furthering their education and ultimately improve our community.
2. Eligibility considerations are as follows:
 - a. Graduating seniors who attend community college, public colleges or universities, private universities or eligible trade schools;
 - b. Proof of high school graduation;
 - c. Participation in mandatory YAC activities;
 - d. Served the Second District YAC a minimum of one year (scholarships are \$250 for each year served on the council).
