BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated August 29, 2017 (Agenda Item 3.119), the County of Riverside (County) Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of the Polk Street Resurfacing and Sidewalk Improvement Project in the Community of Thermal. The resurfacing project and the sidewalk project was combined to bid as one contract in order to accelerate construction of the resurfacing work. Additionally, efficiencies are gained by eliminating multiple bidding and administrative procedures, and by receipt of more favorable bids associated with larger bid quantities.

Polk Street was identified as in need of resurfacing in May 2012. On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB1) was passed to improve the state's aging transportation infrastructure, particularly roads and bridges. Because of this, the County is now able to start improving roads in need of resurfacing or reconstruction. The Polk Street resurfacing project has been included in the County Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). Without SB1 this needed road repair project would have remained shelved until funding became available.

The Polk Street resurfacing project is one of Riverside County's priority projects approved for use of the new Gas Tax/SB-1 funds. In September the State legislature passed SB-135 to allow agencies to spend their own funds to advance the delivery of SB-1 identified projects and reimburse themselves upon receipt of the SB-1 funds, expected in January 2018.

The scope of work includes resurfacing of approximately one mile of existing asphalt concrete pavement on Polk Street from 58th Street to Airport Boulevard, and pavement widening and sidewalk improvements from Church Street to Airport Boulevard.

During the advertisement period, two addenda were issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the plans and specifications. Bidders were required to acknowledge and take into account the issued addenda on their contractor's Bid in order to be considered for award. Both Addenda were issued to clarify and modify the approved contract documents. The addenda are attached and designated as Addendum No. 1 and Addendum No. 2.

The contractor, Sully Miller Contracting Company, is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the contract, and has provided bonds and insurance documents which meet the requirements of the Contract.

C6-0057, Polk Street Sidewalk Improvement Project

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The resurfacing of Polk Street will improve safety and reliability of the road, and the construction of a sidewalk on Polk Street between Church Street and Airport Boulevard will improve safety and mobility for the many residents in the area who walk to businesses and services, including schools, bus stops, markets and the post office

The work is scheduled to begin in late 2017. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately one month to complete.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The contract is recommended to be awarded to Sully Miller Contracting Company for the total amount of \$788,763.

Resurfacing construction will be funded with Gas Tax/HUTA funds, initially. Any Gas Tax/HUTA funds expended to advance the resurfacing improvement, will be reimbursed with Gas Tax/SB-1 funds, upon receipt from the State, expected in January 2018. The sidewalk construction will be funded with Gas Tax/HUTA and SB 821 (Local Transportation Funds), for which the Transportation Department successfully competed.

The project is expected to be completed within the existing budget as shown on Attachment "A".

There are no General Funds used in this project.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Eight bids were received ranging from \$788,763 to \$1,027,416. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

All received bids were responsive to the bidding requirements set forth for the project. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by Sully Miller Contracting Company in the amount of \$788,763 which is \$103,282 (12%) below the Engineer's Estimate.



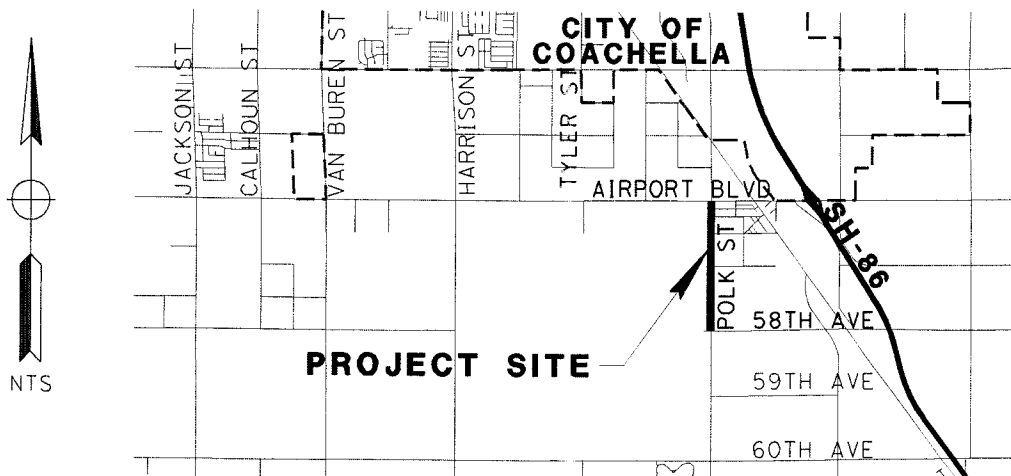

1. The amount of the obligation of this bond is 10% of the amount of the Contractor's Proposal, including bid alternates, and inures to the benefit of County.

This Bond is exonerated by (1) County rejecting said Proposal or, in the alternate, (2) if said Proposal is accepted, Contractor executes the Contract and furnishes the Bonds as agreed to in its Proposal, otherwise it remains in full force and effect for the recovery of loss, damage and expense of County resulting from failure of Contractor to act as agreed to in its Proposal. Some types of possible loss, damage and expense are specified in the Contractor's Proposal.
3. Surety, for value received, stipulates and agrees that its obligations hereunder shall in no way be impaired or affected by any extension of time within which County may accept the Proposal and waives notice of any such extension.
4. This Bond is binding on our heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns.



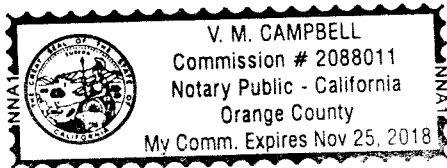
