BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated August 29, 2017 (Agenda Item 3.119), the County of Riverside (County) Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of the Polk Street Resurfacing and Sidewalk Improvement Project in the Community of Thermal. The resurfacing project and the sidewalk project was combined to bid as one contract in order to accelerate construction of the resurfacing work. Additionally, efficiencies are gained by eliminating multiple bidding and administrative procedures, and by receipt of more favorable bids associated with larger bid quantities.

Polk Street was identified as in need of resurfacing in May 2012. On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB1) was passed to improve the state's aging transportation infrastructure, particularly roads and bridges. Because of this, the County is now able to start improving roads in need of resurfacing or reconstruction. The Polk Street resurfacing project has been included in the County Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). Without SB1 this needed road repair project would have remained shelved until funding became available.

The Polk Street resurfacing project is one of Riverside County's priority projects approved for use of the new Gas Tax/SB-1 funds. In September the State legislature passed SB-135 to allow agencies to spend their own funds to advance the delivery of SB-1 identified projects and reimburse themselves upon receipt of the SB-1 funds, expected in January 2018.

The scope of work includes resurfacing of approximately one mile of existing asphalt concrete pavement on Polk Street from 58th Street to Airport Boulevard, and pavement widening and sidewalk improvements from Church Street to Airport Boulevard.

During the advertisement period, two addenda were issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the plans and specifications. Bidders were required to acknowledge and take into account the issued addenda on their contractor's Bid in order to be considered for award. Both Addenda were issued to clarify and modify the approved contract documents. The addenda are attached and designated as Addendum No. 1 and Addendum No. 2.

The contractor, Sully Miller Contracting Company, is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the contract, and has provided bonds and insurance documents which meet the requirements of the Contract.

C6-0057, Polk Street Sidewalk Improvement Project

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The resurfacing of Polk Street will improve safety and reliability of the road, and the construction of a sidewalk on Polk Street between Church Street and Airport Boulevard will improve safety and mobility for the many residents in the area who walk to businesses and services, including schools, bus stops, markets and the post office

The work is scheduled to begin in late 2017. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately one month to complete.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The contract is recommended to be awarded to Sully Miller Contracting Company for the total amount of \$788,763.

Resurfacing construction will be funded with Gas Tax/HUTA funds, initially. Any Gas Tax/HUTA funds expended to advance the resurfacing improvement, will be reimbursed with Gas Tax/SB-1 funds, upon receipt from the State, expected in January 2018. The sidewalk construction will be funded with Gas Tax/HUTA and SB 821 (Local Transportation Funds), for which the Transportation Department successfully competed.

The project is expected to be completed within the existing budget as shown on Attachment "A".

There are no General Funds used in this project.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Eight bids were received ranging from \$788,763 to \$1,027,416. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

All received bids were responsive to the bidding requirements set forth for the project. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by Sully Miller Contracting Company in the amount of \$788,763 which is \$103,282 (12%) below the Engineer's Estimate.





Recitals:

- Contractor has submitted to County his Contractor's Proposal for the construction of County Project, <u>Polk Street</u>, <u>Resurfacing Project</u>, <u>58th Avenue to Airport Boulevard</u>; <u>and Sidewalk Improvement Project</u>, <u>Church Street to Airport Boulevard</u>, <u>Community of Thermal</u>, <u>Project No. C3-0062</u>, <u>C6-0057</u>, in strict accordance with the Contract Documents identified below and County has accepted said Proposal.
- 2. Contractor states that he has reexamined his Contractor's Proposal and found it to be correct, has ascertained that his subcontractors are properly licensed and possess the requisite skill and forces, has reexamined the site and Contract Documents and is of the opinion that he can presently do the work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the money set forth in his Proposal to be paid as provided in the Contract Documents.

It is agreed by the parties as follows:

1. Contract Documents

The entire Contract consists of the following: (a) The Construction Contract, (b) The Notice to Bidders. (c) The Instruction to Bidders, (d) The Bid, (e) The Bid Bond, (f) The Payment Bond, (g) The Performance Bond, (h) The General Conditions, (i) The Special Provisions, (j) The Standard Specifications of the State of California Department of Transportation edition of **2015** as modified in other portions of the Contract Documents and as amended by the State of California Department of Transportation, (k) The Standard Plans of the Department of Transportation identified on the plans or in the Special Provisions, (l) The Plans, (m) Addenda **1,2**, (n) The Determination of Prevailing Wage Rates for Public Works, (o) Any Change Orders issued, and (p) Any additional or supplemental specifications, notice, instructions and drawings issued in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents. All of said Documents presently in existence are by this reference incorporated herein with like effect as if here set forth in full and upon the proper issuance of other documents they shall likewise be deemed incorporated. The Bid Bond is exonerated upon execution of this Contract, the Payment Bond and Performance Bond.

2. The Work

Contractor shall do all tasks necessary to construct the work generally described in Recital No. 1 in accordance with the Contract Documents.

3. Prosecution, Progress and Liquidated Damages

Standard Specification Section 8-1.04B, "Standard Start" is modified to read as follows:

The Contractor shall begin work within <u>fifteen (15)</u> calendar days, or as revised in the Special Provisions, of the date stated within the written "Notice to Proceed".

The Contractor shall notify the Engineer, in writing, of the Contractor's intent to begin work at least 72 hours before work is begun. If the project has more than one (1) location of work, Contractor shall submit a separate notice for each location. The notice shall be delivered to the Transportation Department's Construction Engineer and shall specify the date the Contractor intends to start at said location.

Should the Contractor begin work in advance of receiving a written "Notice to Proceed", any work performed by the Contractor in advance of the date stated in the "Notice to Proceed" shall be considered as having been done by the Contractor at his own risk and as a volunteer and subject to the following:

- A. The Contractor shall, on commencing operations, take all precautions required for public safety and shall observe all the provisions in the Specifications and the Special Provisions.
- B. All work done according to the Contract, prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed", will be considered authorized work and will be paid for as provided in the contract.
- C. The Contractor shall not be entitled to any additional compensation or an extension of time for any delay, hindrance or interference caused by or attributable to commencement of work prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed".






