

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Find that the Nuevo Area Road Rehabilitation Project is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (c) - Existing Facilities; and,
2. Approve the plans and specifications for the construction of the Nuevo Area Rehabilitation Project in the Community of Nuevo; and
3. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, CA 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, January 3, 2018 at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) provides for the construction of the Nuevo Area Roads Rehabilitation Project in the Community of Nuevo. The following roads will be improved with this project.

1. Porter Avenue: east of Palomar Rd to Menifee Rd
2. Mirileste Drive: east of Pasito St to Menifee Rd
3. Via Santana: east of Pablo Street to north of Mirileste Dr
4. Penasco Circle: from Porter St south
5. Macheka Drive: Mirileste Dr to Penasco Circle
6. Pasito Street: Mirileste Dr to end of cul-de-sac
7. Pablo Street: Via Santana to end of cul-de-sac

Roadway rehabilitation is needed due to deteriorated pavement conditions. The scope of work includes removal and replacement of the existing asphalt concrete pavement with new hot mix asphalt, treatment of the underlying base with Portland cement, and additional improvements including removal and replacement of damaged sections of existing curb, gutter, sidewalk, driveways and driveway approaches; reconstruction of cross gutter, relocation of roadside signs, placement of pavement markings, and any other work as may be required.

These streets were initially identified as being in need of rehabilitation in 2004. On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB1) was passed to improve the state's aging transportation infrastructure, particularly roads and bridges. Because of this, the County is now able to improve the condition of roads in need of resurfacing or reconstruction and has included them in the County Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). Without SB1 these needed road repair projects would have remained shelved until funding became available.

The Nuevo area roads rehabilitation project is one of Riverside County's projects approved for use of the new Gas Tax/SB-1 funds. In September 2017, the State legislature passed SB-135 to

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allow agencies to spend their own funds to advance the delivery of SB-1 identified projects and reimburse themselves upon receipt of the SB-1 funds, expected in January 2018.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

Project No.: C7-0051

Environmental Findings

The County Transportation Department is requesting that the Board approve the Notice of Exemption which documents that the project consists of the maintenance, repair and minor alteration of an existing public facility and is exempt under Section 15301 (c) of the CEQA Guidelines.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The purpose of this project is to reconstruct these road segments to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of the road.

The work is scheduled to begin in the spring of 2018. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately one month to complete.

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$1,249,448. Construction is expected to begin and finish in FY 2017/2018 and will be funded with Gas Tax /SB-1 funds.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

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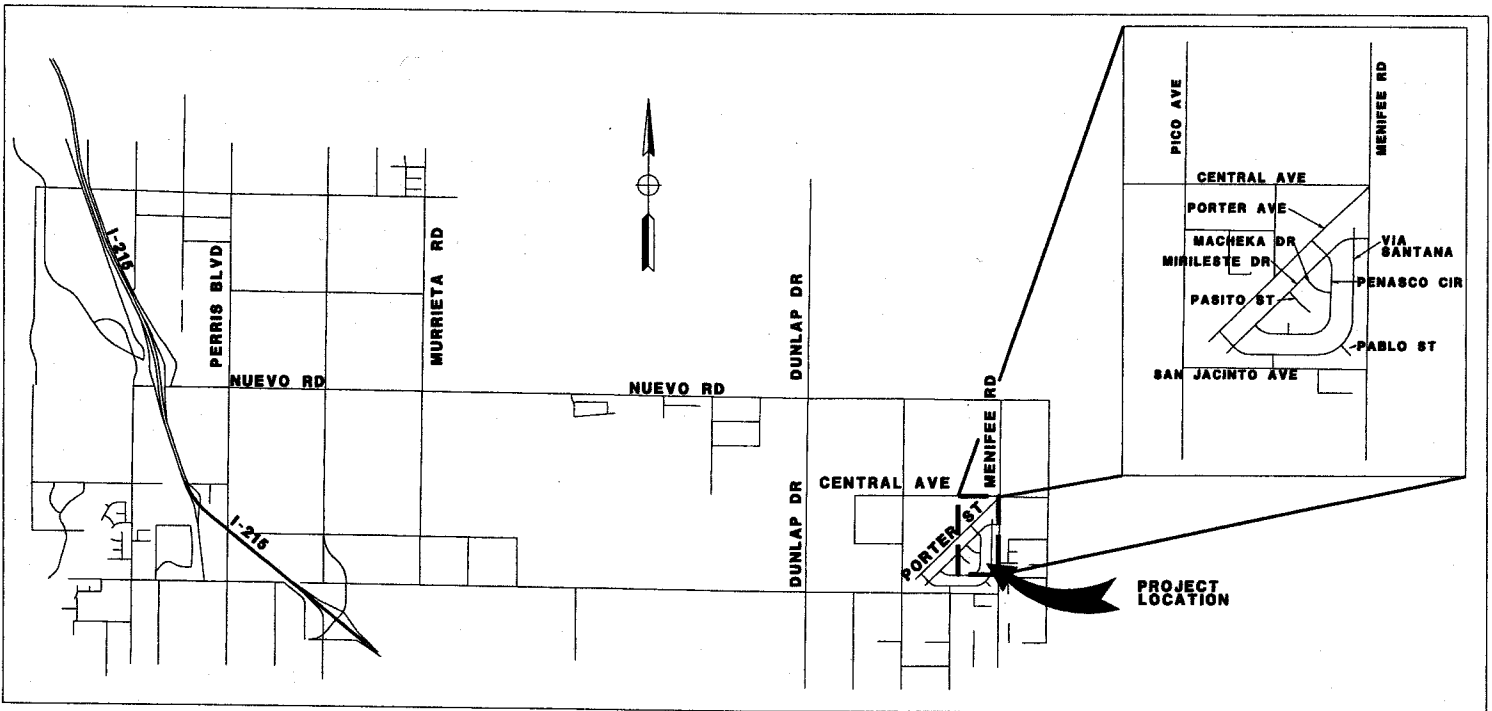
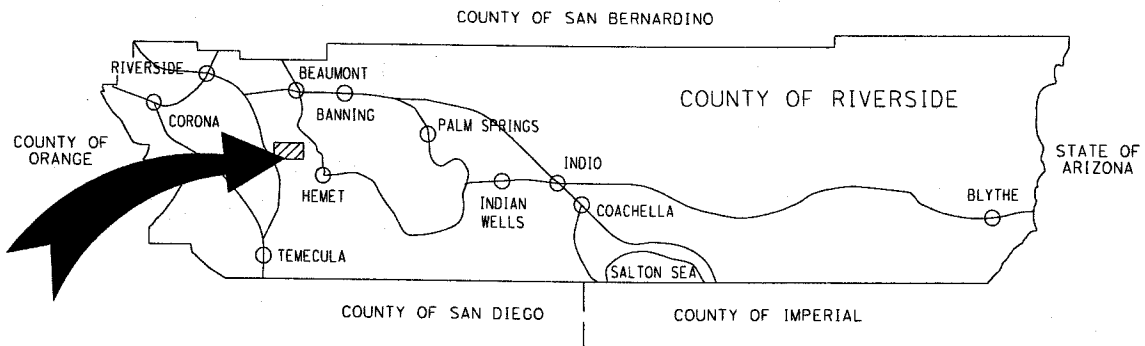

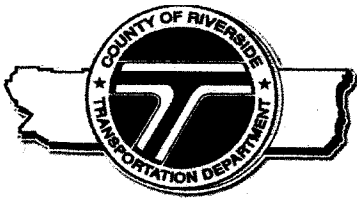

PROJECT SPONSOR: Riverside County Transportation Department

PROJECT LOCATION: North of SR 74 and east of I-215 in the unincorporated area of Nuevo in western Riverside County

SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT: Fifth District

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Riverside County Transportation Department (County) proposes to rehabilitate several streets in the Nuevo area. The roads are:

- Porter Avenue: east of Palomar Rd to Menifee Rd - approximate length of 1850 ft.
- Mirileste Drive: east of Pasito St to Menifee Rd - approximate length of 1550 ft.
- Via Santana: east of Pablo St to north of Mirileste Dr - approximate length of 1868 ft.
- Penasco Circle: from Porter St south - approximate length of 1670 ft.
- Macheka Drive: Mirileste Dr to Penasco Circle - approximate length of 421 ft.
- Pasito Street: Mirileste Dr to end of cul-de-sac - approximate length of 450 ft.
- Pablo Street: Via Santa Ana to end of cu-de-sac - approximate length of 191 ft.

Improvements to these existing roads will include removal and replacement of the existing asphalt and treatment of the underlying base. Replacement of some of the sections of curb, gutter, sidewalk and some of the driveway approaches and/or driveways will occur. Removal of some existing non-native trees will be necessary in order to construct the improvements. Utility relocations may be necessary.

The roads to be improved are two lane (one lane in each direction) public roads in a residential area. The roads vary in width from 26 to 41 feet. Work will be completed within the existing right of way. There are no streambed related activities associated with the project.

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS: The proposed project consists of maintenance and repair to an existing public road, with no expansion of use of the road as a result of the project. The project will benefit the traveling public by providing an improved road surface.

The Western Riverside County Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (WRMSHCP) states that necessary operation and maintenance activities conducted for safety purposes along existing roadways are considered Covered Activities.

The Riverside County Transportation Department has found that the above described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines, based on the following:

Section 15301(c) – Existing Facilities: The project proposes to maintain and repair existing public roads and does not expand the use of the road as a result of the project. Therefore, the project is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301(c).


