### **BACKGROUND:**

### **Summary**

The Clinton Keith Road Extension Project proposes to extend Clinton Keith Road from Interstate 215 (I-215) to State Route 79 (SR-79). This key transportation corridor serving southwest Riverside County between I-215 and SR-79 is a proposed Urban Arterial (six lanes at its ultimate configuration) on both the County and City of Murrieta's General Plan Circulation Element. Since 2006, two portions of Clinton Keith Road between I-215 and SR-79 have been constructed; the portion between I-215 and Whitewood has been widened to six lanes (Phase 1), and the portion between Trois Valley Street and Leon Road has been built to six lanes (Existing). In mid-2016 construction started to extend Clinton Keith Road from Whitewood Road to Trois Valley Street as a four-lane road (Phase 2), Agenda Item 3-15, November 10, 2015.

The Transportation Department is now proposing to widen Clinton Keith Road between Whitewood Road and Trois Valley Street to six-lanes (Phase 4). This project will complete the six-lane arterial (urban) highway in the Community of French Valley and City of Murrieta between Interstate 215 and Leon Road.

Construction of the portion of Clinton Keith Road between Leon Road and SR-79 (Phase 3), will include a bridge over French Valley Creek and will occur at a future date, as funding becomes available.

Phase 4 proposes to construct two lanes and median improvements between Whitewood Road and Trois Valley Street and will complete the ultimate improvements of Clinton Keith Road to a 6-lane urban arterial highway from I-215 to Leon Road. This improvement will allow traffic to proceed along Clinton Keith Road to SR-79, via Leon Road and Max Gillis Boulevard. Construction of Phase 4 will be coordinated with the Phase 2 construction, so that both Phase 2 and Phase 4 will be completed together and opened as a 6-lane facility.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

# **Environmental Findings**

SEIR No. 398 (SCH#1995062022) was completed in compliance with the State of California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines and certified by the Board of Supervisors on February 7, 2006, for the Clinton Keith Road Extension Project. Additionally, on June 2, 2015, the Board considered an Addendum to the SEIR that analyzed the construction phasing of the project.

Phase 4 project is consistent with the SEIR and the Addendum to SEIR No. 398. No new environmental documentation is required because the two lanes, median and associated improvements were adequately addressed in the SEIR and Addendum. No new environmental effects have been identified, and no substantial increase in severity of the environmental effects have been identified. Also, no considerably different mitigation measures have been identified, and no mitigation measures found feasible have become feasible. The construction of Phase 4 is an implementing action in furtherance of the Project and is consistent with the characteristics evaluated in the SEIR and the Addendum. Nothing further is required because all potentially significant effects have been adequately addressed in the SEIR and the Addendum.

# **Impact on Citizens and Businesses**

Public outreach to area residents and schools will occur prior to and throughout construction. A traffic management plan will be in place to address access during construction for residents and emergency vehicles.

Construction of the additional two lanes of Clinton Keith Road will provide an additional east-west connection between I-215 and State Route 79.

The construction duration established for this project is approximately 4 months and construction is anticipated to be completed in the Summer of 2018.

### SUPPLEMENTAL:

### **Additional Fiscal Information**

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$5,306,712. Construction is anticipated to begin in FY 2017/2018 and finish in FY 2018/2019.

The project will be funded with Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC) Measure A funds and Clinton Keith Road Community Facilities District (CFD).

There are no General Funds used in this project.





PROJECT NAME: Clinton Keith Road Extension Project, Phase 4

LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION: The Clinton Keith Road Extension Project is located within the Community of French Valley and the City of Murrieta. The Project will provide a six lane roadway from Whitewood Road to SR 79 (Winchester Road) when all phases are constructed. Phase 2 construction is underway, and will construct four of the six lanes from Whitewood Road to Trois Valley Street, including a bridge at Warm Springs Creek, a wildlife overcrossing and undercrossing, traffic signals and other associated improvements.

Phase 4 of the Clinton Keith Road Extension Project includes the construction of the inside two lanes, median improvements, a sidewalk on the north side, striping and other associated improvements, within the Phase 2 limits of Whitewood Road to Trois Valley Street. Construction of Phase 4 will complete the six lane improvements from Whitewood Road to Trois Valley Street.

A Final Environmental Impact Report No. 398 was certified in 2000 for the Clinton Keith Road Extension Project and a Supplement to Environmental Impact Report No. 398 was approved for the Project in 2006. An Addendum to the Supplement to the EIR No. 398 was approved in 2015. The Supplement to the EIR and the Addendum to the Supplement to the EIR addressed the construction improvements included within Phase 4.

- 1. An Environmental Impact Report, a Supplement to the Environmental Impact Report and an Addendum to the Supplement to the EIR were prepared and certified for the Clinton Keith Road Extension Project, pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 2. The construction of Phase 4 is an implementing action in furtherance of the Project and is consistent with the characteristics evaluated in the SEIR and Addendum.
- 3. Nothing further is required because all potentially significant effects have been adequately addressed in the SEIR and Addendum.
