BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Southwest Communities Financing Authorities (SCFA) Joint Powers Agreement (JPA), dated November 30, 2004 joined together the interests of the Cities of Canyon Lake, Lake Elsinore, Murrieta, Temecula, Wildomar and the County of Riverside to construct and operate an animal shelter. The animal shelter is located within the geographic area common to all parties. SCFA was established as a public entity, separate and apart from the parties as a JPA to provide for the animal shelter needs to eligible residents.

This First Amendment to the Third and Restated Joint Powers Agreement amends the term of the Chairperson and Vice Chairperson of the JPA Board of Directors, as identified in Section 8(a), from annual to bi-annual.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The purpose of the SCFA Joint Powers Agreement is to exercise the common powers of the parties/cities involved in the housing and operation of the animal shelter in order to serve the residents of that area. The JPA Board of Directors can better serve its residents and conduct the management and operation of the shelter with bi-annual membership terms of the chairperson and vice-chairperson.

Creating the Southwest Communities Financing Authority (Animal Shelter)

This 1st Amendment to the Third Amended and Restated Joint Powers Agreement ("Agreement") is made and entered into as of 12000 Pr 2017, by and between the members of the Southwest Communities Financing Authority ("SCFA") RECITALS

SCFA, a California joint powers authority, entered into the Third Amended and Restated Agreement on November 2, 2010. The Agreement is amended as follows:

- 1. Section 8. Officers and Employees subsection a, is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following language:
 - (a) <u>Chairperson and Vice Chairperson</u>. The Board may select a chairperson and a vice chairperson from among its members at its first meeting. The term of the Chairperson and Vice Chairperson, when selected in this manner, shall be for two (2) years.

In the event that the Chairperson or Vice Chairperson so elected resigns from such office or creases to be a member of the Board, the resulting vacancy shall be filled at the next regular meeting of the Board. In the absence or inability of the Chairperson to act, the Vice Chairperson shall act as Chairperson. The Chairperson, or in the Chairperson's absence, the Vice Chairperson, shall preside at and conduct all meetings of the Board.

- 2. Except as set for in this Amendment, the Contract is unaffected and shall continue in full force and effect in accordance with its terms. If there is conflict between this amendment and the Agreement or any earlier amendment, the terms of the First Amendment will prevail.
- 3. If any of this 1st Amendment or the Contract is declared invalid, illegal or otherwise unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect.
