



**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

The Desert Center Nazarene Church applied for and received funds from the First Solar Community Fund, Desert Center area, for the benefit of the Desert Center community at large. The Church used these funds to purchase two (2) Thermal Imaging Cameras and propose donating them to the Riverside County Fire Department Battalion 8 Blythe.

A Thermal Imaging Camera (TIC) is a type of thermographic camera used in firefighting. By rendering infrared radiation as visible light, such cameras allow firefighters to see areas of heat through smoke, darkness, or heat-permeable barriers. It is a valuable tool for our Department.

The transfer is beneficial for the Riverside County Fire Department as well as the surrounding Cities and Unincorporated areas. The Thermal Imaging Cameras will be located at Ripley Fire Station 44 and Lake Tamarisk Fire Station 49 in the Blythe area.
