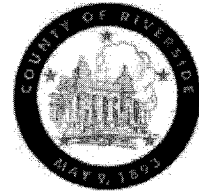

BACKGROUND:

Summary

A Cooperative Agreement between the County of Riverside (County) and Caltrans, for the construction of the Newport Road Interchange Project was approved by the Board of Supervisors on July 1, 2014 (Agenda Item 3-53). In September 2017, the County completed the construction of the Project which provided for a wider freeway overcrossing, new ramps and landscaping improvements. Although the Project improvements have been completed, the County is responsible for a three year plant establishment period prior to Caltrans accepting maintenance responsibility for the Project.

This Amendment No. 1 to the Cooperative Agreement will allow Caltrans to grant the County a partial relief of maintenance for the interchange improvements. Once the three year plant establishment period is completed and Caltrans accepts the landscaping improvements, the landscaping improvements will be maintained by Caltrans.

This agreement has been reviewed and approved to form by County Counsel. Work Order No.: B5-0682

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Newport Road is one of the key east-west corridors in southwestern Riverside County. The interchange serves developing areas in the City of Menifee and unincorporated County.

Additional Fiscal Information

In addition to City of Menifee funding, the construction of the project has been funded utilizing Menifee Road and Bridge Benefit District, Transportation Uniform Mitigation Fee, Federal Surface Transportation Program, Eastern Municipal Water District and Southern California Gas Company funding.

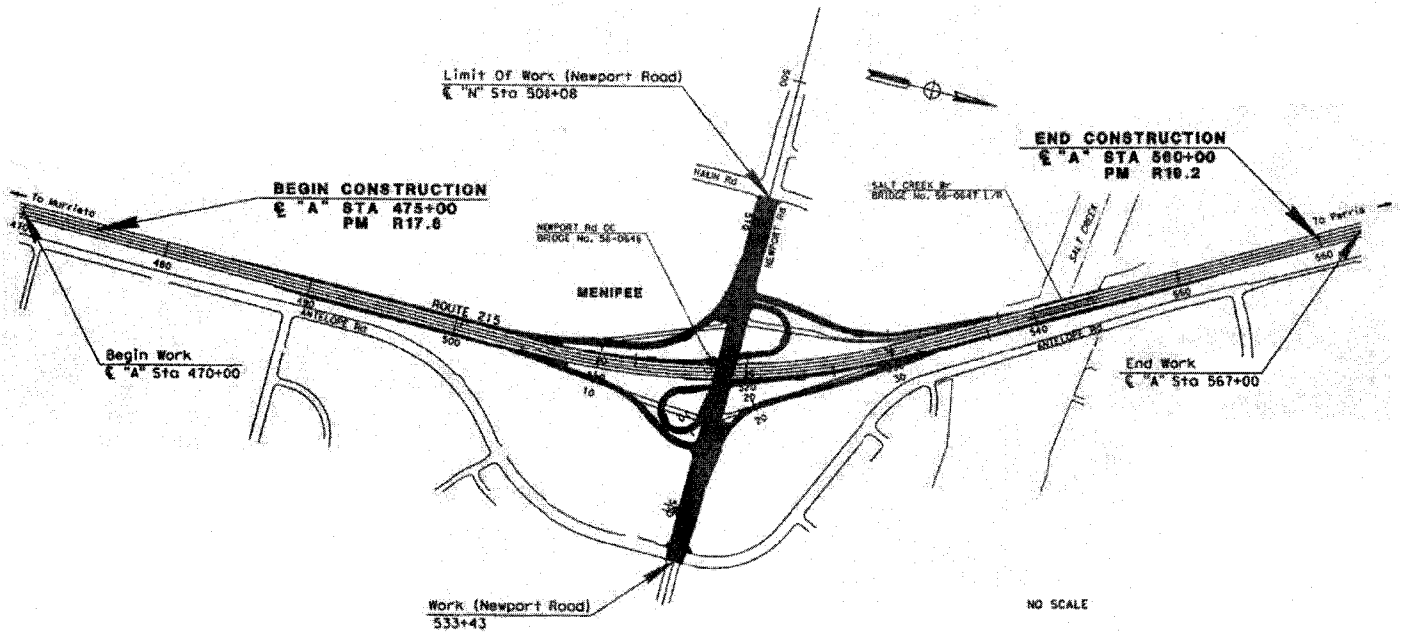
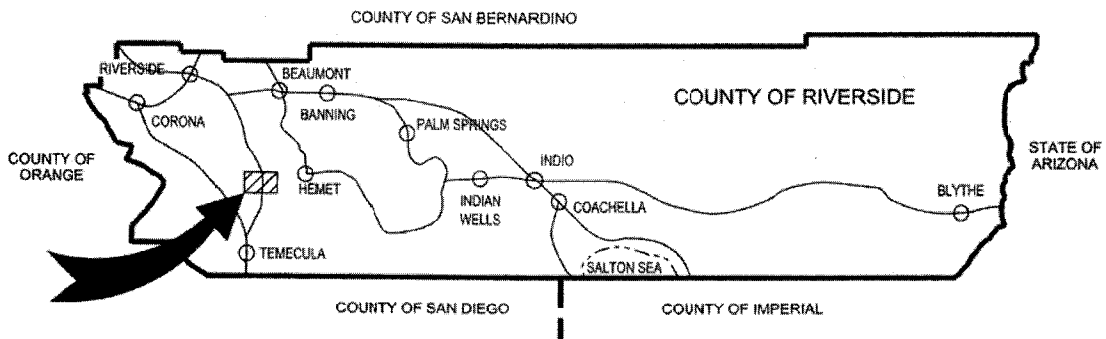

AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO AGREEMENT 08-1574 A/1

THIS AMENDMENT No. 1 (AMENDMENT), entered into and effective on February 7, 2018, is between the State of California, acting through its Department of Transportation, referred to as CALTRANS, and

County of Riverside, a political subdivision of the State of California, referred to hereinafter as COUNTY.

RECITALS

1. CALTRANS and COUNTY, collectively referred to as PARTNERS, entered into Agreement No. 08-1574, (AGREEMENT) on July 16, 2014, to reconstruct Newport Road at Interstate 215 (I-215) from 4 to 6 through lanes between Haun Road and Antelope Road, relocate northbound (NB) and southbound (SB) exit ramps (3 lanes), reconfigure NB & SB entry ramps to include High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lane, add new NB and SB loop entry ramps (2 lanes), include extended ramp acceleration/deceleration lanes, add extended dedicated right-turn lanes, referred to as PROJECT.
2. PARTNERS now seek to revise the language to permit partial Relief of Maintenance for completed segments of the PROJECT.

IT IS THEREFORE MUTUALLY AGREED:

1. Article 64 in the AGREEMENT is replaced in its entirety to read as follows:

“64. As IMPLEMENTING AGENCY for CONSTRUCTION, COUNTY is responsible for maintenance within PROJECT limits as part of the construction contract until a request from COUNTY is submitted and approved by CALTRANS for a relief of maintenance for any portion of the PROJECT in accordance with CALTRANS Standard Specifications.”
2. All other terms and conditions of the AGREEMENT shall remain in full force and effect.
3. This AMENDMENT is deemed to be included and made part of the AGREEMENT.

SIGNATURES

PARTNERS declare that:

1. Each PARTNER is an authorized legal entity under California state law.
2. Each PARTNER has the authority to enter into this AGREEMENT.
3. The people signing this AGREEMENT have the authority to do so on behalf of their public agencies.


