- 3. Direct the Clerk of the Board to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk within five (5) working days of approval by the Board.

BACKGROUND:

<u>Summary</u>

In 2007, storm drain facilities referenced as Murrieta Valley – George Avenue Storm Drain were constructed in association with the development of Tract Map 30155. The majority of the facility was constructed within the limits of the subdivision with the exception of an inlet structure and access road which were constructed east of George Avenue between Varian Way and Doheny Circle within the city of Wildomar. Per terms of the development, the District was granted an easement to operate and maintain the facilities offsite of the subdivision by quitclaim deed which was recorded on April 20, 2012 as Instrument No. 2012-0181345, thereafter referenced as RCFC Parcel 7234-500.

In 2016, Tract Map 31479 was conditioned to construct flood control improvements extending the existing storm drain facilities east of George Avenue. The District and the City of Wildomar approved the plans and the facility has now been constructed. The City of Wildomar has also accepted the new facility for operation and maintenance. The District no longer needs the rights granted in Parcel 7234-500 for maintenance as the right of way has been modified and is now all within street right of way.

The project is exempt from CEQA because it satisfies the intent of a "Class 12 Categorical Exemption" pursuant the State CEQA Guidelines Section 15312, "Surplus Government Property Sales." The project is also consistent with Section 15061(b)(3), "Common Sense Exemption" because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the proposed project may have a significant effect on the environment, as it is merely vacating an unnecessary flood control easement for parcels that are no longer needed, nor will be needed in the future, for the District's use and purposes.

District staff has determined that the use of the easement is no longer required pursuant to the modification of the real property and new facility. The rights herein described have been declared surplus and not required for the District's purposes pursuant to the adoption of Resolution No. F2017-20 on November 14, 2017.

Therefore, the District recommends that the easements, recorded on April 20, 2012 as Instrument No. 2012-0181345, referred to as RCFC Parcel No. 7234-500, be summarily vacated and relinquished.

Resolution No. F2017-22 has been approved as to form by County Counsel.



WHEREAS, the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District ("District") is the owner of certain real property interests known as RCFC Parcel 7234-500 over portions of land identified with Assessor's Parcel Numbers 362-731-011 through 362-731-018 (the "ROW"), which was granted via quitclaim deed, recorded as Instrument No. 2012-0181345 on April 20, 2012, which encompasses 0.089 acre of land located east of George Avenue between Varian Way and Doheny Circle within the city of Wildomar, County of Riverside; and

WHEREAS, the storm drain facility which was within the property has been removed and an alternate facility has been constructed within the street right of way; and

WHEREAS, on November 14, 2017, the District's Board of Supervisors (Board) adopted Resolution No. F2017-20 declaring the ROW as surplus that it is no longer needed, nor will be needed in the future, for the District's use and purposes, and provided notice of its intention to summarily vacate and relinquish the ROW; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Water Code Appendix Chapter 48-9, Subsection 5 Chapter 48-13, the District may dispose of real property after adoption of a resolution declaring that a real property interest is no longer necessary to be retained for the District's use and purposes as was previously adopted and noted in Resolution No. F2017-20; and

WHEREAS, the District has reviewed and determined the vacation and relinquishment of the ROW as categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15312, "Surplus Government Property Sales"

as the District is merely vacating an unnecessary flood control easement because the easement interest is no longer needed, nor will be needed in the future, for the District's use and purposes. Furthermore, the project is also consistent with State CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3), "Common Sense Exemption" because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the proposed project may have a significant effect on the environment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by vote of the Board of Supervisors of the District, in regular session assembled on December 12, 2017, in the meeting room of the Board of Supervisors of the District located on the 1st Floor of the County Administrative Center, 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside, California, at 9:00 a.m. or soon thereafter, based on the review of the proposed vacation and relinquishment, the environmental impacts of the project have been sufficiently assessed and have been determined that the proposed action qualifies for a "Class 12 Categorical Exemption" pursuant to Article 19 of the CEQA, State CEQA Guidelines: Section 15312 and Section 15061(b)(3) because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question will have a significant effect on the environment because the District is merely vacating an unnecessary right of way on undisturbed property and the vacation of the easement does not adversely affect a change in the environment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by vote of this Board that the exempt property is no longer necessary to be retained by the District for public purposes and authorizes the summary vacation and relinquishment of the ROW, RCFC Parcel 7234-500 that certain real property located in the city of Wildomar, County of Riverside, State of California, more particularly described in Exhibits "A" and "B", to the City of Wildomar.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Clerk of Board is directed to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk within five (5) working days of approval by the Board.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Clerk of the Board is directed to cause a certified copy of this Resolution to be recorded in the office of the Recorder of the County of Riverside, California



The project is located in the city of Wildomar and includes approximately one acre of vacant undisturbed land approximately 500 feet southeast of the La Estrella Street and George Avenue intersection. The project affects the following Assessor's Parcel Numbers (APNs) 362-731-011, 362-731-012, 362-731-013, 362-731-014, 362-731-015, 362-731-016, 362-731-017, and 362-731-018. The project is within Township 6 South, Range 3 West, Section 31 of the Murrieta 7.5 Minute USGS Topographic Quadrangle map. The properties are located approximately 33° 36' 10.63" N, 117° 14' 26.16" W (Lat/Long).

Project Description:

The Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District) is the owner of certain real property right of way easement interests over land identified by the aforementioned APNs. The easement interests are no longer needed nor will they be needed in the future for the District's use and purposes. Therefore, pursuant to California Water Code Appendix Section 48-9, Subsection 5 and Chapter 48-13, the District may dispose of real property when interest is no longer necessary to be retained for District use or purposes. The District proposes to relinquish property rights by summarily vacating the easement interest in APNs 362-731-011, 362-731-012, 362-731-013, 362-731-014, 362-731-015, 362-731-016, 362-731-017, and 362-731-018.

Public Agency Approving Project: Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District

Public Agency Carrying Out Project: Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District

Exempt Status: Categorical Exemption Pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines §§15312 and 15061(b)(3)

Reasons Why Project is Exempt: The project qualifies for the following CEQA exemptions:

Section 15312: Class 12 Categorical Exemption, "Surplus Government Property Sales", consists of sales of surplus government property except for parcels of land located in an area of statewide, regional, or area-wide concern identified in Section 15206(b)(4). The Lead Agency (District) has determined that the proposed project is not of statewide, regional, or area-wide significance. Although the project does not include any exchange of funds or "sale," this exemption is appropriate because whether or not there is any monetary exchange, the primary action is relinquishing or vacating surplus government property/property rights, and in this case, doing so would not adversely affect the environment.

Section 15061(b)(3): The project qualifies for the "General Rule" or "Common Sense Exemption" because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the proposed project may have a significant effect on the environment. The District is merely vacating an unnecessary flood control easement on undisturbed property.

The project does not affect a change in the environment. The project will not result in any specific or general exceptions to the validity of the categorical exemptions as detailed under State CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2. The project will not cause any impacts to scenic resources, historic resources, or unique sensitive environments. Furthermore, no unusual circumstances or potential cumulative impacts would reasonably occur that may create an environmental impact.

Based upon the exemptions identified above, the District hereby concludes that no physical environmental impacts are anticipated to occur and the project as proposed is exempt under CEQA. No further environmental analysis is warranted.
