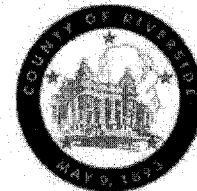





**BACKGROUND:**

1. The donation to the Rotary Club of Corona will be used to sponsor their annual fundraiser, which utilizes other non-profits to provide services and equipment, and all funds raised address issues such as children at risk, hunger and literacy.
2. The donation to League of United Latin American Citizens (LULAC) will be used to sponsor a health fair on February 24, 2018 at the Cesar Chaves Community Center and will include dental treatments, eye exams, medical exams, mammograms and flu shots.
3. The donation to Corona Life Services will be used to help provide more service hours at their clinic where they offer testing, ultra sounds, childbirth education, parenting classes, fatherhood support and material goods to families in need.
4. The donation to Riverside County Works will be used to sponsor the Jamil Dada Character Counts Youth Awards Ceremony where youth from each supervisorial district receive recognition for their academic and athletic achievements and for showing exemplary character while overcoming some of life's most difficult situations.
