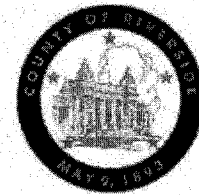





BACKGROUND:

1. The donation to the United Way of the Inland Valleys will be used to sponsor the GEMS (Girls Excelling in Mathematics with Success) Program, which was originally created by Professor Pam Clute, out of her desire to engage with the next generation of women who demonstrate excellence in mathematics, with a focus on middle-school aged girls.
2. The donation to Circle City Rotary will be used to sponsor their annual fundraiser "Fire & Ice" which raises funds for non-profits in the Corona area.
3. The donation to the Corona Norco Family YMCA will be used for building upgrades at the Home Gardens and Jurupa Valley sites.
