BACKGROUND: Summary

In order to meet the growing needs of the County and to deliver more efficient and effective library services throughout the County, the Riverside County Library System (County Library) has requested that the Real Estate Division of the Economic Development Agency (EDA) pursue a request for proposals (RFP) process in order to consider and potentially deliver new libraries on County owned property, through a public, private partnership method. Upon approval of this item, EDA will pursue an RFP process which includes proposal analysis, developer selection and in depth lease negotiations. EDA will return to the Board with details of any negotiated lease agreements for consideration by the Board of Supervisors at a future date.

The County currently owns three properties in the French Valley, Menifee, and Desert Hot Springs areas which have been designated for library facilities. The selected developer(s) will ground lease County owned land from the County, develop the project, and through a building lease, lease the new libraries to the County for occupancy by the County Library. The building lease will provide for the County to pay a competitive modified gross lease rate and provide the County with the option to purchase the building improvements during the lease term and/or at the end of the lease term. In addition, the selected developer(s) will plan and construct parking facilities on the site for use by the public and library staff.

These proposed library facilities and properties are detailed as follows:

- <u>French Valley</u> Library facility will be proposed as approximately 25,000 square feet, and the facility will be constructed on a portion of Assessor's Parcel Number 480-160-021, as set forth on the attached Exhibit A. This is a new library branch. The current population in French Valley is approximately 31,254. There are currently no library services provided in this area of the County.
- Menifee Library facility will be proposed as approximately 20,000 square feet, and the
 facility will be constructed on a portion of Assessor's Parcel Number 364-152-034, as set
 forth on the attached Exhibit B. This is a new library branch. The current population in
 Menifee is approximately 91,164, and the existing Menifee library 2016-2017 visits were

227,720. The visitors utilize library services for research, education, entertainment, and career enhancement. This will be a new branch in addition to the existing Sun City branch.

<u>Desert Hot Springs</u> – Library facility will be proposed as approximately 15,000 square feet, the facility will be constructed on a portion of Assessor's Parcel Number 656-040-060, as set forth on the attached Exhibit C. This is a replacement branch. The current population in Desert Hot Springs is approximately 28,989, and the existing Desert Hot Springs library 2016-2017 visits were 72,263. The visitors utilize library services for research, education, entertainment, and career enhancement. The current existing library is 3,527 square feet.

Each facility will be a modern and state-of-the-art library and include a computer lab for research and training purposes, plug in technology areas for customers with lap tops, smart phones and other devices, self-checkout stations, electronic bulletin boards to inform customers of library programing and services and improved telephone and wireless capabilities. These new proposed facilities will serve to enhance and improve customer service and ADA access.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

These new proposed facilities will provide enhanced programs and services that will better serve these growing regions of the County and there will be a positive impact on both residents and local businesses.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

There are sufficient funds in the County Library Fund FY19-20 budget to fund these new libraries. No additional County funds are required.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

These are new proposed library facilities and EDA will pursue negotiated agreements that consider current market conditions and reasonable delivery and pricing.




