

**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

The Advisory Council on Aging is the official local area advisory council, as mandated by the Federal Older Americans Act and the State Older Californians Act. The council is a volunteer leadership body, composed of seventeen (17) members, advising the Board of Supervisors (Board) and the Office on Aging on matters related to development of the Office on Aging Strategic Plan, administration of the plan, and operations conducted under the plan.

Pursuant to Resolution #2005-148, Uniform Rules and Procedures for Advisory Committees, Boards and Commissions of the County of Riverside, and in accordance with Board Policy A-21, the Office on Aging and the Advisory Council on Aging respectfully request the Board retroactively re-appoint Doris Morgan-Hayes to the Advisory Council on Aging, for the period July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2020. 
