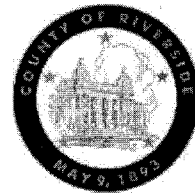

BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be allocated to the following organizations:

1. **League of United Latin American Citizens of Riverside Council #3190 - \$1,500** funds will be used to assist the 5th Annual Free Community Health Fair. At this event, located in the 1st District, participants will receive free dental, vision and medical services. Up to 1,500 participants are expected to attend.
2. **Riverside National Cemetery Support Committee- \$2,000** funding will be used to assist the Concert for Heroes at the Riverside National Cemetery. This event is free and open to the public.
3. **Riverside County Office of Education Foundation - \$2,000** funding will be used to assist efforts to provide scholarships to disadvantaged high school students residing in the First District.
