

BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Riverside National Cemetery Support Committee - \$2,500 the funding will be used for the 2017 Concert for Heroes, which celebrates the men and women who have served their country.
2. Riverside County Works - \$1,000 the funds will be used for the 13th Annual Jamil Dada Character Excellence Youth Awards Ceremony, which recognizes youths for their academic and athletic achievements while overcoming difficult situations in life.
3. Rancho Damacitas Children & Family Services - \$2,500 the funds will be used to support Project Independence, which provides emancipated youth with housing, as well as mentors that teach independent living skills, literacy, nutrition and self-care, job searching skills, and higher education and/or vocational entry requirements.
