**BACKGROUND:** Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. United States Veterans Initiative - \$2,500 the funding will be used to provide supportive services that will help individual veterans and veteran families exit homelessness and return to permanent housing.
2. Big Brothers Big Sisters of the Inland Empire - \$500 the funds will be used for the Bowl For Kids' Sake Fundraiser, which helps the organization to support over 950 at-risk kids, each with their own mentor.
3. Trauma Intervention Programs of Southwest Riverside County - \$1,000 the funds will be used to support specially trained citizen volunteers who provide emotional and practical support to victims of traumatic events and their families.
4. Temecula Valley Chamber of Commerce - \$1,000 the funds will be used for the 2018 Awards Gala, which honors exceptional businesses, charitable organizations, and individuals for demonstrating strong community involvement and leadership.
