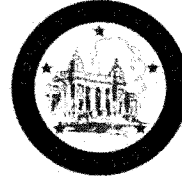



**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

On December 15, 2015 (Item #3-48), the Board of Supervisors approved county-wide personal service agreements for both unarmed and armed security guard services with a total of six (6) vendors. GSSi, Inc. (formerly General Security Services, Inc.) was approved for unarmed security services in this action. Agreements for each vendor, including GSSi, were for an annual, not-to-exceed, amount of \$250,000, and renewable annually for a period of up to four years.

The Department of RUHS – Behavioral Health’s demand for security services has increased over the past year. Since the approval of the original contract, the department has added new building sites and increased security service to 24/7 with their current security provider GSSi, Inc. This increased level of service necessitates an increase to the current annual, not-to-exceed amount for GSSi of \$250,000. RUHS-Behavioral Health desires to continue to utilize a single vendor to provide security services as it is more manageable and provides service continuity to the department. In order to meet the need for a single vendor to provide this service to RUHS- Behavioral Health, the Board is being asked to increase the not-to-exceed annual amount from \$250,000 to \$1,450,000 for FY 17/18 and \$1,700,000 for FY 18/19 for GSSi, Inc.

**Impact on Residents and Businesses**

Security guards protect the safety of county personnel, the public, and county property by providing a visual presence throughout County buildings. In the event of an emergency, security guards provide an immediate response while law enforcement or medical services are summoned.

**Additional Fiscal Information**

The funding increase for services provided by GSSi, Inc. is for the final two years of the anticipated term of four years. RUHS-Behavioral Health will use state and federal funds for the security services, no general funds will be used for this contract.

**Contract History and Price Reasonableness**

On December 15, 2015 (M.O. 3-48), the Board of Supervisors approved four contracts for unarmed security guard services with California Panther Security, Inc., Power Security, Inc., High Quality Security, and GSSi, Inc. (formerly General Security Service, Inc.) and six armed security guard services with CEED Security, World Private Security, California Panther Security, Inc., Power Security, Inc., High Quality Security and GSSi, Inc. The awards were made to the vendors as a result of a competitive bid process (RFQ# PUARC-1355). It was determined to award to multiple contractors recognizing the large geographical area of coverage and the level of service required by various county departments. Each vendor was approved with an annual amount not to exceed \$250,000.

Amendment No. 1, 2, and 3 with GSSi, Inc. were issued for annual contract renewals and/or compensation allowances as provided for in the contract approved by the Board on December 15, 2015. Approval of Amendment No. 4 with GSSi, Inc., will allow RUHS -Behavioral Health to address the increase of operational needs of the department and provide service continuity. The Board is requested to approve an increase to the not-to-exceed amount for the unarmed security guard contract with GSSi, Inc. from \$250,000 to \$1,450,000 for FY 17/18 and from \$250,000 to \$1,700,000 for FY 18/19.

The amendment has been approved as to form by County Counsel.


The Personal Service Agreement for Riverside County Unarmed Security Guard Services between County of Riverside, a political subdivision of the State of California (COUNTY) and General Security Services, Inc., predecessor-in-interest to GSSi, Inc., a California corporation (CONTRACTOR), entered into as of December 15, 2015, first amended on June 1, 2016, amended the second time as of August 1, 2016, and amended the third time as of August 1, 2017 (collectively, "Agreement"), is amended as follows:


1. Section 3.1 (Compensation). The second sentence in Section 3.1 is hereby deleted and replaced in its entirety by the following: "The estimated maximum payments by COUNTY to CONTRACTOR shall not exceed one million four hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$1,450,000) annually, including all expenses, for fiscal year 2017/2018 (July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2018) and one million seven hundred thousand dollars (\$1,700,000) annually, including all expenses, for fiscal year 2018/2019 (July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019).
2. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement not modified herein shall remain unchanged. The provisions of this amendment shall prevail over any inconsistency or conflicting provisions of the Agreement, as heretofore amended, and shall supplement the remaining provisions thereof.

**IN WITNESS WHEREOF**, the Parties hereto have caused their duly authorized representatives to execute this amendment.
