BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Riverside County Office of Education Foundation - \$2,500 will be utilized for the scholarships for the "Come Back Kids" academy which is a program that inspires confidence in students seeking diplomas.

2. Big Brothers Big Sisters of the Inland Empire - \$500 the funding will be used for a fundraiser for the "Road to Success Program" a mentoring program for youth.

3. American Association of University Women Temecula Valley - \$2,000 the funding will be used for the "Tech Trek" program camp scholarships for middle school girls which focuses on STEM subjects and college attendance.

4. Manzanita Ranch Inc. - \$2,500 the funding will be used to offer horse therapy for veterans and first responders with PTSD and other disabilities.
