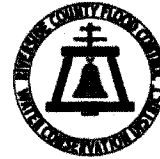





BACKGROUND:

Summary

Section 18 of the District Act requires the Board of Supervisors to hold a public hearing for the purpose of considering all comments regarding proposed facilities before authorizing construction of such facilities.

The Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District) in partnership with the City of Norco, is proposing to construct and maintain the project. The primary project objective is to alleviate the flooding and debris buildup currently experienced by the community after a moderate storm. The project includes 3,250 lineal feet of underground storm drain and a small debris basin.

Pursuant to Section 15282(k) of the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") Guidelines, construction of new pipeline and demolition of existing pipeline that does not exceed one (1) mile in length is statutorily exempt from CEQA. Additionally, Section 15304 of the State CEQA Guidelines exempts minor alterations to land such as grading on land with a slope of less than 10%. Furthermore, based on the environmental analysis that has been conducted, the project would not result in any adverse impacts to any environmental resources. As such, in accordance with CEQA a Notice of Exemption has been prepared and the Clerk of the Board will file the Notice of Exemption within five (5) days of the Board approving the project if said project is approved at the February 27, 2018 Board of Supervisors meeting.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Improved flood protection and public safety in the project vicinity.

9 WHEREAS, Act 6642 of the State Legislature, Section 18 of the Riverside County Flood
10 Control and Water Conservation District Act ("District Act") requires that the Riverside County
11 Flood Control and Water Conservation District ("District") give public notice and conduct a public
12 hearing prior to undertaking construction of District facilities; and,

13 WHEREAS, this Board of Supervisors ("Board") intends to undertake a project within the
14 city of Norco in the County of Riverside designated as the Norco MDP Line NA-1, Stage 2 and
15 Norco MDP Lateral NA-1A, Stage 1 Project ("Project"); and,

16 WHEREAS, the Project is generally bounded to the north, south, east and west by rural
17 residential and undeveloped land located west of the intersection of Crestview Drive and 6th Street;

19 WHEREAS, the Project proposes a total of 3,250 lineal feet of underground storm drain

21 WHEREAS, the Project will not adversely affect special status species, disturb or remove

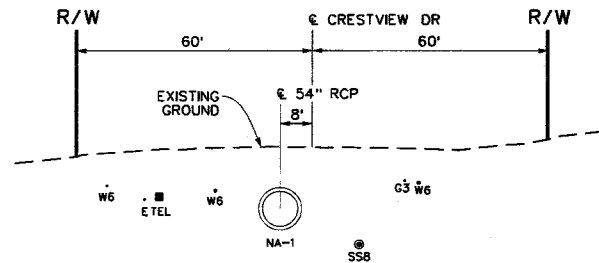

and Vicinity Map**

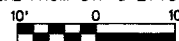


**Norco MDP Line NA-1

ENGINEER'S STATEMENT

The proposed Norco MDP Line NA-1, Stage 2 and Norco MDP Lateral NA-1A, Stage 1 project is located within the city of Norco in the neighborhoods surrounding the intersection of Crestview Drive and Mt. Rushmore Drive, at the foot of the La Sierra Hills. The primary project objective, as defined in the approved project charter, is to alleviate the flooding and debris buildup currently experienced by the community after a moderate storm. The project includes the construction of a storm drain system which will collect and convey runoff from the La Sierra Hills and help relieve the community of flooding issues for the 10-year storm event. The project also includes the construction of a small debris basin to reduce the amount of mud/debris laden flows through the community.

The cost of the proposed project is approximately \$3,000,000.

Project Location – City: Norco

The proposed project is located in a developed area within the city of Norco, Riverside County, California just west of the intersection of Crestview Drive and 6th Street. The project is centered at approximate latitude/longitude 33° 56' 39.77" N and 117° 31' 24.43" W. The site is within the United States Geological Survey (USGS) 7.5-Minute Series map Corona North, within Township 3 South, Range 6 West, Section 4 (USGS 1981).

Project Description and Existing Setting: The Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (RCFC) proposes to construct minor flood control improvements in the city of Norco. Improvements include construction of two pipelines completely within existing street right of way and a small debris basin. Line NA-1 involves the removal of 525 LF of reinforced concrete pipe (RCP) and replacement with 1,880 LF of RCP within Crestview Drive and 120 LF of RCP within Mt. Shasta Drive. Lateral NA-1A involves the construction of approximately 1,250 LF of pipeline within Mt. Rushmore Drive. The proposed earthen debris basin site has less than 10% slopes, is devoid of wetlands, waterways and vegetation, and is disturbed/disked regularly. There are no environmental resources of hazardous or critical concern within the project vicinity, no hazardous waste sites as listed in Section 65962.5 of the Government Code in the project vicinity and no unusual circumstances associated with the project. No scenic or historical resources would be affected by the project. Once constructed, the only activity at the site would be infrequent (annual) maintenance, such as basin tracking and weed abatement/vegetation control.

Public Agency Approving and Carrying out the Project: RCFC


Exempt Status: Statutory Exemption [Section 15282(k)] and Class 4 Categorical Exemption [Section 15304(a)]

Reasons Why Project is Exempt: Section 15282(k) of the CEQA Guidelines statutorily exempts pipeline projects less than one mile in length including the installation of new pipeline or maintenance, repair, restoration, removal, or demolition of an existing pipeline. The project proposes construction of approximately 3,250 LF (0.62 mile) of pipeline and removal of 525 LF of pipeline, therefore, this exemption applies.

The project is also consistent with the Class 4 Categorical Exemption (State CEQA Guidelines Section 15304) which exempts Minor Alterations to Land such as grading for the earthen basin. Based on the above project description and existing setting, the exceptions to the Class 4 Categorical Exemption, as listed in Section 15300.2 of the State CEQA Guidelines, do not preclude the applicability of the use of the categorical exemption.

Based on the information provided, the District hereby concludes that no significant environmental impacts will occur and the project, as proposed, is exempt under CEQA. No further environmental analysis is warranted.

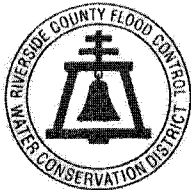

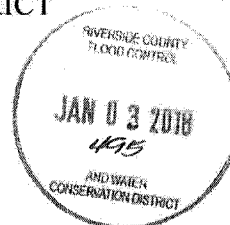

CDFW imposes and collects a filing fee to defray the costs of managing and protecting California's vast fish and wildlife resources, including, but not limited to, consulting with other public agencies, reviewing environmental documents, recommending mitigation measures, and developing monitoring programs.

Annual Fee Adjustments

CDFW is required to adjust the fees annually (Fish & G. Code, § 713). Annual filing fee adjustments are posted on CDFW's website prior to November 1 of the year before they become effective.

Payment of Fees

The project proponent is responsible for payment of the filing fee (Fish & G. Code, § 711.4). Filing Fees are due at the time a Notice of Determination is filed with the county clerk's office (local lead agency), or with the State Clearinghouse (state lead agency). Fees due for Certified Regulatory Program (/Conservation/CEQA/Procedures/Commission) notices are due to CDFW directly and before the respective Notice of Decision is filed with the Secretary for Natural Resources.

Exemptions and No Effect Determinations

The CEQA filing fee will be waived if a project will have no effect (/Conservation/CEQA/NED) on fish and wildlife (Fish & G. Code, § 711.4, subd. (c)(2)(A)). Additionally, projects that are statutorily or categorically exempt from CEQA are also not subject to the filing fee and do not require a no effect determination (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, §§ 15260-15333; Fish & G. Code, § 711.4, subd. (d)(1)). Only CDFW staff is responsible for determining whether a project will qualify for a No Effect Determination and if the CEQA filing fee will be waived.
