



BACKGROUND:

Summary

Background:

An estimated 13,100 DACA beneficiaries live in Riverside County, according to analysis of U.S. Census Bureau and U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services data by the USC Center for the Study of Immigration Integration.

DACA, Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals, was a program that granted work permits and temporary protection from deportation to nearly 790,000 young people who came to the United States before age 16. The program was established by President Barack Obama's administration in 2012. In September 2017, the federal government took action to begin rescinding DACA, giving Congress a six-month period to come up with a solution.

Many of these young people, referred to as Dreamers, have given back to our community and country. In fact, approximately 900 DACA beneficiaries serve in the U.S. military, holding health care and/or language skills considered vital to our national interest. Unless legislative action is taken, these individuals could lose their work authorization and face removal.

Riverside County is one of the most diverse areas of the United States, and that diversity keeps us strong and vibrant. The development of a comprehensive and functioning immigration system is essential to ensuring our county's and America's future economic prosperity.

For these reasons, the Board has long been supportive of comprehensive immigration reform, unanimously adopting Resolution 2013-050 in 2013. While a rational and functioning immigration system is more than 20 years overdue, the wind-down of the DACA program presents a historic opportunity for Congress to offer a long-term resolution to one of the more complicated aspects of immigration, the status of those who came to this country before adulthood.

There are several pending proposals in Congress that would enable a pathway to permanent legal status for young people who had DACA status. They differ in elements ranging from eligibility requirements, to the degree of conditional permanent residency and path to citizenship, to the scope of the overall proposed fix.

The intent of this Resolution is not to prescribe one approach over another, but to endorse and encourage bipartisan, bicameral negotiation that emerges into a timely agreement that helps these young people, as well as our economy, school system, and colleges and universities.

TO SUPPORT DREAMERS AND DACA LEGISLATIVE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, many people around the world leave their home country to come to the United States in pursuit of opportunities for them, their family and their children, often enduring danger in their journey to an unfamiliar land; and

WHEREAS, facing many hardships in search of a better life, immigrants bring their talents to work hard and contribute to our society, making us strong and vibrant, and giving us a powerful advantage in global competition in an increasingly interconnected world; and

WHEREAS, immigrants define who we are as a country, a nation of adopted sons and daughters and their descendants, united by a common bond of freedom that we owe to the Constitution of the United States and the men and women who defend our country; and

WHEREAS, Riverside County is home to a vast immigrant community, with foreign-born individuals comprising 22 percent of the county's population, a valuable part of our economy and community; and

WHEREAS, a comprehensive and functioning immigration system is essential to ensuring our county's and America's future economic prosperity; and

WHEREAS, for these reasons, the Board has long been supportive of comprehensive immigration reform, unanimously adopting Resolution 2013-050 in 2013; and

WHEREAS, amid the wind-down of the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals, DACA, program, one of the most pressing concerns is the status of those who came to this country before adulthood; and

3 knowingly violated immigration laws; and

16 incorporating the statements set forth above, that we call upon our federal representatives to
17 support a legislative solution to DACA that offers opportunities for Dreamers to stay in this
18 country and, ultimately, offers opportunities to those who wish to enhance their ability to
19 contribute to our community and country by becoming citizens of our great nation.

21 reiterate the need for comprehensive and non-discriminatory immigration reform that includes
22 enhanced border security, improved employment screenings and deportation of non-citizen
23 felons upon release.


