Summary

Construction of the Landfill Gas Collection System Expansion for Fiscal Year 2017/2018 Phase 1 at the Badlands Sanitary Landfill was satisfactorily completed by Tetra Tech BAS, Inc. at a cost of \$57,689.70 (Retained Funds of \$2,884.48) and staff therefore recommends approval of the Notice of Completion. The Notice of Completion here is for completed work associated with a Notice to Proceed dated 10/03/17.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

This contract ensures the Department's ability to efficiently collect and monitor the landfill gas generated at the Badlands, Corona, Double Butte, and Lamb Canyon landfills to maintain compliance with air quality regulations.

Additional Fiscal Information

This is an administrative action to file a Notice of Completion for only the Construction of Landfill Gas Collection System Expansion Fiscal Year 2017/2018 Phase 1 at the Badlands Sanitary Landfill. No funds are being requested.

This contract expired on October 20, 2017. During the term of the contract, a total of six (6) construction phases have been completed at the Badlands Landfill, five (5) phases at the Lamb Canyon Landfill and one (1) phase at the Double Butte Landfill. A cost summary by construction phase and location is summarized below. The total amount of the contract expended was \$919,515.65. Department staff recommends authorization by the Board of Supervisors to release the retained funds to the contractor, Tetra Tech BAS, in the amount of \$2,884.48 for the above referenced phase of work in accordance with the contract terms and applicable law.

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

On October 21, 2014 (item 12-1C), the Board awarded Tetra Tech BAS, Inc., a three-year contract for Construction of Landfill Gas Collection System Expansion and Probe Installation at the Badlands, Corona, Double Butte, and Lamb Canyon Sanitary Landfills for the total amount of \$1,234,020.70.

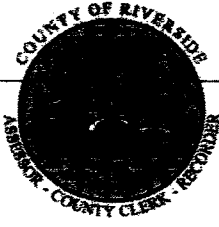

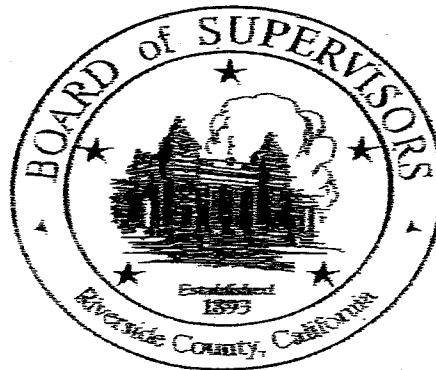
