



BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation funds will be given to the following organizations:

1. Fair Housing Council of Riverside County, Inc. - \$1,000 for sponsorship of the 5th Annual Housing Conference to address issues identified as impediments to housing choice for residents of Riverside County.
2. Mt. San Jacinto College Foundation - \$1,000 to support the Mt. San Jacinto Foundation scholarship programs.
3. Calicinto Ranch, Inc. - \$25,000 the funding will be used to upgrade building shade structures for year around use for the health and safety of foster and at risk children attending the camp at the ranch.
