BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Riverside County Probation Department (Probation) and Riverside County Regional Park and Open-Space District (RivCoParks) will work together to provide services for the Alan M. Crogan - Youth Treatment and Educational Center Youths (YTEC Youths) at RivCoParks locations throughout Riverside County. This volunteer program allows Probation to have access to additional services for the YTEC Youths to train and expand their knowledge for future job opportunities and facilitates YTEC Youths' completion of court ordered community service hours through volunteering at RivCoParks locations. Probation Correction Officers transport and supervise YTEC Youths at all times during the performance of volunteer hours at RivCoParks.

Through this mutually beneficial program, Probation works collaboratively with RivCoParks to continue receiving access to services and programs as they become available for community service and job training opportunities throughout Riverside County for Probation clients while providing maintenance, rehabilitation and improvement assistance at various RivCoPark locations.

The Memorandum of Agreement has been approved by County Counsel as to legal form. A companion item will appear on the RivCoParks Board of Directors agenda.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Probation's mission is "Serving Courts, Protecting our Community, and Changing Lives." Probation is proposing to continue seeking opportunities for probation youths to participate in meaningful volunteer services and programs that provide them with valuable learning experiences, in order to improve success rates while enabling them to make positive contributions to their community, as well as providing for the safety and well-being of county residents.

1	3.0	<u>TERM</u>
2		This MOA shall be effective and commence upon execution by signature of the Parties,
3		and will end on June 30, 2023, unless terminated or modified as defined in section 4.0 of
4		this MOA.
5		
6	4.0	AMENDMENT OR TERMINATION OF MOA
7		This MOA, along with any incorporated attachments, fully expresses all understandings of
8		the Parties concerning all matters covered and shall constitute the total MOA. No
9		addition to, or alteration of, the terms of this MOA whether by written or verbal
10		understanding of the parties, their officers, agents or employees, shall be valid unless
11		made in the form of a written amendment to this MOA formally approved and executed
12		by both Probation and RivCoParks.
13		
14		This MOA may be amended at any time with the written concurrence of all parties.
15		Consideration for amendment will be given upon written notification by one party to the
16		other. Probation and RivCoParks will review this MOA at least annually and modify as
17		needed. This MOA can be terminated with or without cause by either party upon thirty
18		(30) days written notification to the other party or due to unavailability of funding.
19		Termination of the MOA will take effect thirty (30) days following receipt of the written
20		notice of termination or upon effective date of funding expiration.

1	6.0	ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES
2		Probation and RivCoParks mutually agree to the YTEC work program as described in the
3		following roles and responsibilities:
4		
5		6.1 RivCoParks shall:
6		 Assign staff to be a liaison between RivCoParks and Probation;
7		 Coordinate and plan scheduled work days with YTEC program director;
8		 Provide equipment (including personal protective equipment) needed to
9		perform clean-up, rehabilitation, and improvements to trails and park
10		facilities;
11		 Provide RivCoParks volunteer orientation for Probation staff and YTEC Youths
12		at onset of each event day;
13		 Communicate with and inform Probation staff of any issues, concerns,
14		injuries, or other pertinent information; and
15		 Review the work being performed under this MOA, annually, to determine if
16		it merits continued service provision.
17		
18		6.2 Probation shall:
19		 Screen the YTEC Youths to find those who are within the parameters of what
20		is agreeable between the Parties (no sexual assault, cruelty to animals or
21		violent history). YTEC Youths must be 14 years of age or older;
22		 Coordinate and plan scheduled work days with RivCoParks Volunteer
23		Services Coordinator;
24		 Assign a minimum of two officers to transport and supervise YTEC Youths at
25		all times while performing volunteer services. The number of YTEC Youths
26		participating at any given time shall be limited to six. At least one officer will
27		be the same gender of the YTEC Youth being supervised;
28		 Ensure YTEC Youths are dressed in proper community service clothing for the
29		event;
30		 Provide consumables such as water, snacks, and lunch as needed for YTEC
31		Youths on event work days;
32		 Review the work being performed under this MOA, annually, to determine if
33		it merits continued service provision.
34		

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

7.0 RECORDS RETENTION

Each party agrees to retain all records pertaining to this MOA for the period indicated in the Riverside County Records Retention General Schedule per Board of Supervisors Policy A-43 unless otherwise indicated by the source of funds. If, at the end of the retention period, there is ongoing litigation or an audit involving those records, each party shall retain the original records until the resolution of such litigation or audit.

8.0 CONFIDENTIALITY

All parties agree to maintain the confidentiality of all YTEC Youths information in accordance with all applicable Federal, State and local laws and regulations. Both parties will ensure names, addresses, phone numbers, and any other individually identifiable information concerning YTEC Youths and services received are kept confidential.

9.0 HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFICATION

Each party (referred to as "indemnitor") shall indemnify and hold harmless the other party including its officials, officers, employees and agents (referred to as "indemnities") from any liability, damage, claim or action based on or asserted upon any actions or services of indemnitor, its officials, officers, employees or agents related to this MOA, including but not limited to property damage, bodily injury or death. Indemnitor shall defend, at its sole expense (including all costs and fees, including but not limited to attorney fees, cost of investigation, defense and settlements or awards) in any claim or action based upon such acts or services.

10.0 ASSIGNMENT

This MOA shall not be assigned by any party hereto, either in whole or in part, without prior written consent of the other parties. Any assignment or purported assignment of this MOA without the prior written consent will be deemed void and of no force or effect.

11.0 LICENSE AND CERTIFICATIONS

All parties verify upon execution of this MOA that it will possess all current and valid licenses/certifications in compliance with any applicable local, State, and Federal laws and that all roles and responsibilities set forth in section 6.0 shall be performed by properly trained and licensed/certified staff.

1	12.0	SEVERABILITY
2		If any provision in this MOA is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, void
3		or unenforceable, the remaining provisions will nevertheless continue in full force without
4		being impaired or invalidated in any way.
5		
6	13.0	COMPENSATION
7		No Party to this Agreement shall be obligated to pay any monetary compensation to the
8		other. Further no party to this Agreement shall be obligated to pay any third party as a
9		result of this Agreement.

11	14.0	<u>NOTICES</u>
