

3. Award the contract to Sukut Construction, LLC. and authorize the Chairman of the Board to execute the contract documents.



BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated December 5, 2017 (Agenda Item 3.36), the County of Riverside (County) Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of the Clinton Keith Road Phase 4. Upon completion, Clinton Keith Road will be a six-lane arterial (urban) highway in the Community of French Valley and City of Murrieta. The construction of Clinton Keith Road is needed to provide an east-west urban arterial highway between Interstate 215 (I-215) and State Route 79 (SR-79)/Winchester Road. Phase 1 was completed by the City of Murrieta, and included full improvements on Clinton Keith Road between I-215 and Whitewood Road. Due to limited funds, the County separated the project into phases to best utilize available funds.

Phase 2, the 4-lane section between Whitewood Road and Leon Road, is currently under construction. The Board of Supervisors authorized the contract award for Construction of the Clinton Keith Road Extension Project (Phase 2) by Minute Order dated November 10, 2015 (Agenda Item 3-15).

Phase 3, the section of Clinton Keith Road from Leon Road to SR-79, will be constructed in the future as this section is significantly more expensive and needs to be coordinated with the future development project in the NW quadrant of Clinton Keith Road and SR-79.

Phase 4 will construct the inside two lanes and median improvements within the Phase 2 limits from Whitewood Road to Leon Road. This will complete the ultimate improvements of Clinton Keith Road to a 6-lane urban arterial highway from I-215 to Leon Road and will allow traffic to proceed along Clinton Keith Road to SR-79, via Leon Road and Max Gillis Boulevard. Construction of Phase 4 will be coordinated with the Phase 2 construction, so that both Phase 2 and Phase 4 will be completed together and open as a 6-lane facility.

During the advertisement period, two addenda were issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the plans and specifications. Bidders were required to acknowledge and take into account the issued addendum on their contractor's Bid in order to be considered for award.

The Addendum 1 was issued to extend the bid receipt date and Addendum 2 was issued to clarify and modify the approved contract documents. Both addenda are attached herewith as Addendum No. 1 and Addendum No. 2.

The contractor, Sukut Construction, LLC. is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the contract, and has provided bonds and insurance documents which fulfill the requirements of the Contract.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Public outreach to area residents and schools will occur prior to and throughout construction. A traffic management plan will be in place to address access during construction for residents and emergency vehicles.

Construction of the additional two lanes of Clinton Keith Road is part of providing additional east-west capacity between I-215 and State Route 79.

The construction duration established for this project is approximately 4 months and construction is anticipated to be completed in the summer of 2018.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The contract is recommended to be awarded to Sukut Construction, LLC. for the total amount of \$4,987,654. The project will be funded with Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC) Measure "A" funds and Clinton Keith Road Community Facilities District (CFD).

The project is expected to be completed within the existing budget as shown on Attachment "A".

There are no General Funds used in this project.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Three bids were received ranging from \$4,987,654 to \$5,597,324. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid.


All received bids were responsive to the bidding requirements set forth for the project. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by Sukut Construction, LLC. in the amount of \$4,987,654 which is \$350,349 (6.6%) below the Engineer's Estimate.



The Field Office must be provided with a facsimile machine with a separate phone line and a copying machine capable of photocopying 11" x 17" size paper and of making color copies for the exclusive use of the Engineer and the Engineer's staff for the entire duration of the project.

21. Two (2) dry erase whiteboard 4' x 6' or larger and dry erase markers.
22. Coffee machine with regular maintenance and delivery of coffee, creamer, sugar and artificial sweeteners.

Construction

You must meet with the Engineer prior to construction (and at any other time circumstances warrant), and together, must mutually agree on a location for the field office. Approval of the proposed Field Office by the Engineer must be obtained before implementation.

The Field Office must be maintained in a clean, neat and sanitary manner at all times. All sanitary paper products required for the restroom must be supplied by you.

Payment

No monthly progress payments will be due you until all provisions and requirements of "Resident Engineer's Office" are complete and in place.

The contract lump sum price paid for Resident Engineer's Office shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals and for doing all the work involved in furnishing and maintaining Resident Engineer's Office, including furnishing and maintaining the listed equipment and furniture, and providing of all necessary supplies for the listed equipment for the duration of the contract work, as specified in these Special Provisions, and as directed by the Engineer, and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor.

Contract

THIS CONTRACT is entered into at Riverside, California as of the date set forth below is between County of Riverside hereafter called "County" and **Sukut Construction, LLC**, hereafter called "Contractor".

WITNESSETH

Recitals:

1. Contractor has submitted to County his Contractor's Proposal for the construction of County Project, **Clinton Keith Road Construction Project – Phase 4, Whitewood Road to Leon Road, In the City of Murrieta and French Valley Area, Project No. B2-04724**, in strict accordance with the Contract Documents identified below and County has accepted said Proposal.
2. Contractor states that he has reexamined his Contractor's Proposal and found it to be correct, has ascertained that his subcontractors are properly licensed and possess the requisite skill and forces, has reexamined the site and Contract Documents and is of the opinion that he can presently do the work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the money set forth in his Proposal to be paid as provided in the Contract Documents.

Agreement:

It is agreed by the parties as follows:

1. Contract Documents

The entire Contract consists of the following: (a) The Construction Contract, (b) The Notice to Bidders, (c) The Instruction to Bidders, (d) The Bid, (e) The Bid Bond, (f) The Payment Bond, (g) The Performance Bond, (h) The General Conditions, (i) The Special Provisions, (j) The Standard Specifications of the State of California Department of Transportation edition of **2015** as modified in other portions of the Contract Documents and as amended by the State of California Department of Transportation, (k) The Standard Plans of the Department of Transportation identified on the plans or in the Special Provisions, (l) The Plans, (m) Addenda **1, 2**, (n) The Determination of Prevailing Wage Rates for Public Works, (o) Any Change Orders issued, and (p) Any additional or supplemental specifications, notice, instructions and drawings issued in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents. All of said Documents presently in existence are by this reference incorporated herein with like effect as if here set forth in full and upon the proper issuance of other documents they shall likewise be deemed incorporated. The Bid Bond is exonerated upon execution of this Contract, the Payment Bond and Performance Bond.

2. The Work

Contractor shall do all tasks necessary to construct the work generally described in Recital No. 1 in accordance with the Contract Documents.

3. Prosecution, Progress and Liquidated Damages

Attention is directed to the provisions in Section 8-1.04, "Start of Job Site Activities", Section 8-1.05, "Time", and in Section 8-1.10 "Liquidated Damages" of the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions.

Standard Specification Section 8-1.04B, "Standard Start" is modified to read as follows:

The Contractor shall begin work within fifteen (15) calendar days, or as revised in the Special Provisions, of the date stated within the written "Notice to Proceed".

The Contractor shall notify the Engineer, in writing, of the Contractor's intent to begin work at least 72 hours before work is begun. If the project has more than one (1) location of work, Contractor shall submit a separate notice for each location. The notice shall be delivered to the Transportation Department's Construction Engineer and shall specify the date the Contractor intends to start at said location.

Should the Contractor begin work in advance of receiving a written "Notice to Proceed", any work performed by the Contractor in advance of the date stated in the "Notice to Proceed" shall be considered as having been done by the Contractor at his own risk and as a volunteer and subject to the following:

- A. The Contractor shall, on commencing operations, take all precautions required for public safety and shall observe all the provisions in the Specifications and the Special Provisions.
- B. All work done according to the Contract, prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed", will be considered authorized work and will be paid for as provided in the contract.
- C. The Contractor shall not be entitled to any additional compensation or an extension of time for any delay, hindrance or interference caused by or attributable to commencement of work prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed".

4. Compensation

Contractor shall be paid in the manner set forth in the Contract Documents the amount of his Proposal as accepted by County, the above rates, subject to additions and deductions as provided in the Contract Documents. Said Proposal is on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of County.

SECURITY DEPOSITS IN LIEU OF RETENTION**

This Escrow Agreement is made and entered into on the _____ of _____ 2018, by and between Riverside County Transportation Dept., whose address is 3525 14th Street, Riverside, CA 92501, hereinafter called "Owner"; Sukut Construction, LLC, whose address is 4010 W. Chandler Avenue, Santa Ana, CA 92704 hereinafter called "Contractor", and Banner Bank, a State chartered bank, whose address is 1750 Howe Avenue, Suite 100, Sacramento, California 95825, hereinafter called "Escrow Agent".

For the consideration hereinafter set forth, the Owner, Contractor, and Escrow Agent agree as follows:

- (1) Pursuant to Section 22300 of the Public Contract Code of the State of California, Contractor has the option to deposit securities with Escrow Agent as a substitute for retention earnings required to be withheld by Owner pursuant to the Construction Contract entered into between the Owner and Contractor for the Clinton Keith Road Construction Project - Phase 4, Whitewood Road to Leon Road, in the City of Murrieta and French Valley Area, Project No.B2-04724 in the amount of ***Four Million, Nine Hundred Eighty Seven, Six Hundred Fifty Four Dollars*** (\$4,987,654.00) (hereinafter referred to as "Contract"). Alternatively, on written request of the Contractor, the Owner shall make payments of the retention earnings directly to the Escrow Agent. When the Contractor deposits the securities as a substitute for Contract earnings, the Escrow Agent shall notify the Owner within 10 days of the deposit. The market value of the securities at the time of the substitution shall be at least equal to the cash amount then required to be withheld as retention under the terms of the Contract between the Owner and Contractor. Securities shall be held in the name of County of Riverside, and shall designate the Contractor as the beneficial owner.
- (2) The Owner shall make progress payments to the Contractor for those funds which otherwise would be withheld from progress payments pursuant to the Contract provisions, provided that the Escrow Agent holds securities in the form and amount specified above.
- (3) When the Owner makes payment of retentions earned directly to the Escrow Agent, the Escrow Agent shall hold them for the benefit of the Contractor until the time that the escrow created under this Contract is terminated. The Contractor may direct the investment of the payments into securities. All terms and conditions of this agreement and the rights and responsibilities of the parties shall be equally applicable and binding when the Owner pays the Escrow Agent directly.
- (4) Contractor shall be responsible for paying all fees for the expenses incurred by the Escrow Agent in administering the Escrow Account and all expenses of the Owner. These expenses and payment terms shall be determined by the Owner, Contractor and Escrow Agent.
- (5) The interest earned on the securities or the money market accounts held in escrow and all interest earned on that interest shall be for the sole account of Contractor and shall be subject to withdrawal by Contractor at any time and from time to time without notice to the Owner.
- (6) Contractor shall have the right to withdraw all or any part of the principal in the Escrow Account only by written notice to Escrow Agent accompanied by written authorization from the Owner to the Escrow Agent that Owner consents to the withdrawal of the amount sought to be withdrawn by Contractor.

- (7) The Owner shall have a right to draw upon the securities in the event of default by the Contractor. Upon seven days' written notice to the Escrow Agent from the Owner of the default, the Escrow Agent shall immediately convert the securities to cash and shall distribute the cash as instructed by Owner.
- (8) Upon receipt of written notification from the Owner certifying that the Contract is final and complete, and that the Contractor has complied with all requirements and procedures applicable to the Contract, Escrow Agent shall release to Contractor all securities and interest on deposit less escrow fees and charges of the Escrow Account. The escrow shall be closed immediately upon disbursement of all moneys and securities on deposit and payments of fees and charges.
- (9) Escrow Agent shall rely on the written notification from the Owner and the Contractor pursuant to Sections (5) to (8), inclusive, of this Agreement and the Owner and Contractor shall hold Escrow Agent harmless from Escrow Agent's release and disbursement of the securities and interest as set forth above.


