BACKGROUND:

Summary

The District, in partnership with the City of Norco, is proposing to construct and maintain the project. The primary project objective is to alleviate the flooding and debris buildup currently experienced by the community after a moderate storm. The project includes 3,250 lineal feet of underground storm drain and a small debris basin.

Pursuant to Section 15282(k) of the CEQA Guidelines, construction of new pipeline and demolition of existing pipeline is statutorily exempt from CEQA as long as the project does not exceed one mile in length. Additionally, Section 15304 of the State CEQA Guidelines exempts minor alterations to land such as grading on land with a slope of less than 10%. Furthermore, based on the environmental analysis that has been conducted, the project would not result in adverse impacts. As such, in accordance with CEQA a Notice of Exemption has been prepared by the District and should be filed with the County Clerk no more than five days after the date of the project approval.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Improved flood protection and public safety in the project vicinity.



ENGINEER'S STATEMENT

The proposed Norco MDP Line NA-1, Stage 2 and Norco MDP Lateral NA-1A, Stage 1 project is located within the city of Norco in the neighborhoods surrounding the intersection of Crestview Drive and Mt. Rushmore Drive, at the foot of the La Sierra Hills. The primary project objective, as defined in the approved project charter, is to alleviate the flooding and debris buildup currently experienced by the community after a moderate storm. The project includes the construction of a storm drain system which will collect and convey runoff from the La Sierra Hills and help relieve the community of flooding issues for the 10-year storm event. The project also includes the construction of a small debris basin to reduce the amount of mud/debris laden flows through the community.

The cost of the proposed project is approximately \$3,000,000.



Code Regs., tit. 14, §§ 15260-15333; Fish & G. Code, § 711.4, subd. (d)(1)). Only CDFW staff is responsible for determining whether a project will qualify for a No Effect Determination and if the CEQA filing fee will be waived.



WHEREAS, Act 6642 of the State Legislature, Section 18 of the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District Act ("District Act") requires that the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District ("District") give public notice and conduct a public hearing prior to undertaking construction of District facilities; and,

WHEREAS, this Board of Supervisors ("Board") intends to undertake a project within the city of Norco in the County of Riverside designated as the Norco MDP Line NA-1, Stage 2 and Norco MDP Lateral NA-1A, Stage 1 Project ("Project"); and,

WHEREAS, the Project is generally bounded to the north, south, east and west by rural residential and undeveloped land located west of the intersection of Crestview Drive and 6th Street; and,

WHEREAS, the Project proposes a total of 3,250 lineal feet of underground storm drain and a small debris basin; and,

WHEREAS, the Project will not adversely affect special status species, disturb or remove hazardous materials or result in significant cumulative impacts; and,

WHEREAS, the District has reviewed the Project and determined that it is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15282(k) which exempts pipelines less than one (1) mile in length and Section 15304 Minor Alterations to Land; and,

WHEREAS, a Section 18 map bearing the name and showing the general location and typical cross sections of the Project is attached hereto as Attachment A, and on file with the Clerk of the Board; and,

WHEREAS, the engineering cost estimate of the Project titled "Engineer's Statement" is attached hereto as Attachment B, and on file with the Clerk of the Board; and,

WHEREAS, on February 27, 2018, the date of the Section 18 Public Hearing, the Board will consider the Project under Resolution No. F2018-02; and,

WHEREAS, the Section 18 map and the Engineer's Statement for the Project are posted on the District's website at http://rcflood.org under the CEQA/Section 18 tab and may be inspected at the District's office located at 1995 Market Street, Riverside, California 92501 or at the Norco Public Library located at 3954 Old Hamner Road, Norco, California 92860; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 18 of the District Act, prior to making a decision on the Project, this Board will consider all written and oral comments; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 18 of the District Act, any person wishing to comment on the Project may do so in writing between the date of this notice and the public hearing, or may appear and be heard at the time and place noted below.

Administrative Center, 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside, California, 92501 at which time all public comments shall be heard.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

Section 18 of the District Act requires the Board of Supervisors to hold a public hearing for the purpose of considering all comments regarding proposed facilities before authorizing construction of such facilities.

The Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District) in partnership with the City of Norco, is proposing to construct and maintain the project. The primary project objective is to alleviate the flooding and debris buildup currently experienced by the community after a moderate storm. The project includes 3,250 lineal feet of underground storm drain and a small debris basin.

Pursuant to Section 15282(k) of the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") Guidelines, construction of new pipeline and demolition of existing pipeline that does not exceed one (1) mile in length is statutorily exempt from CEQA. Additionally, Section 15304 of the State CEQA Guidelines exempts minor alterations to land such as grading on land with a slope of less than 10%. Furthermore, based on the environmental analysis that has been conducted, the project would not result in any adverse impacts to any environmental resources. As such, in accordance with CEQA a Notice of Exemption has been prepared and the Clerk of the Board will file the Notice of Exemption within five (5) days of the Board approving the project if said project is approved at the February 27, 2018 Board of Supervisors meeting.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Improved flood protection and public safety in the project vicinity.
